Last year the media accurately predicted Texas to win the South and Colorado to win the North. ### 11th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

The 11th annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship takes place at Kansas City's Arrowhead Stadium on Saturday, Dec. 2, at 7:00 p.m. (CST) under the television cameras of ABC Sports.

General public tickets are available at all Ticketmaster outlets, by phone at (800) 676-5488 or online at [ticketmaster.com](http://ticketmaster.com). Group tickets and premium ticket packages are available through Arrowhead Stadium at (888) 992-4433.

Tickets are priced at \$80, \$70, \$60 and \$50, plus handling fee.

In the 10-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

### Big 12 BCS Success

The 2005 season marked the third straight and fifth time in the last six years that a Big 12 team played in the BCS National Championship game. Since the inception of the BCS, the Big 12 is 2-3 in the National Championship game and leads all conferences with its five appearances. Texas (2005) and Oklahoma (2000) have won titles, while Nebraska (2001) and Oklahoma (2003, '04) were denied crowns.

### Division Races

Texas wins the South Division with a victory in its final regular-season game. Oklahoma claims the title by winning its last game, coupled with a Texas loss. If both Texas and OU win its remaining games, or if they both lose, the Longhorns and Sooners would share the South Division crown, but UT holds the tie-breaker over Oklahoma by virtue of its head-to-head victory, and would play in the Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship game.

Nebraska has clinched the North Division title for the fourth time in league history. The Cornhuskers will make their first appearance in the Big 12 Championship game since 1999. All-time, NU is 2-1 in the Championship game.

### All-Conference Team

The AT&T Big 12 All-Conference team and individual award winners will be announced by the conference office on Tuesday, November 28.

### Big 12 Bowl Partners

Again this season, the Big 12 has eight bowl slots guaranteed. The Conference is partnered with nine bowls, with the the Gator Bowl and Sun Bowl taking a Big 12 team twice over a four-year period. In the two years in which the Gator does not select a Big 12 team, the Sun Bowl will. Following is the selection order:

- BCS - Fiesta
- Cotton
- Holiday
- Gator (when it selects a Big 12 team)
- Alamo
- Sun (when the Gator does not take a Big 12 team)
- Insight
- Independence
- Texas

### Bowl Eligibility

Heading into the final weeks of the regular-season the Big 12 finds itself with nine teams currently at or better than the NCAA minimum six-win threshold for bowl eligibility. When filling a conference's contracted bowl slots, six-win teams can only be selected provided there are no other teams with winning records available within the conference to fulfill its obligation(s). Teams with winning records must be selected to fill a conference's bowl obligations before six-win teams within the conference can be chosen. Six-win teams are only able to fill at-large spots in bowls outside of existing bowl agreements if there are no other teams with winning records available within Division I-A.

**BAYLOR (4-8, 3-5)**  
End of Season

Punter Daniel Sepulveda finished his career with 94 punts of 50-plus yards and as the Big 12's all-time leader in career punts with 278.

Trent Shelton's 155 receptions rank fourth in Baylor history. He recorded a catch in 45 consecutive games, fourth in Division I-A annals. His 1,978 career receiving yards are fifth in school history.

Dominique Zeigler ended his collegiate career with 166 receptions, second on Baylor's all-time career receptions list and with 1,923 receiving yards, sixth on BU's all-time career receiving yards list.

Baylor's season total attendance of 259,559 is a school record, breaking the previous mark of 240,367 established in 1991. The Bears averaged 37,080 fans for seven games to average 37,000-plus for the second consecutive season.



**COLORADO (2-9, 2-5)**  
This Week: at Nebraska  
End of Season

Bernard Jackson completed 13-of-19 passes for a career-best 200 yards and two touchdowns vs. Iowa State. He finished the game with a career-best passer rating of 191.6, and rushed nine times for 69 yards and another TD. He accounted for 269 yards of total offense, 10 first downs and three scores.

PK Mason Crosby has 305 career points, the first Buff to eclipse the 300 point barrier. In field goal tries this season, his average make is 40.6 yards and average miss is from 51.8.

In the win over Iowa State, Colorado reached 200 yards in both rushing (263) and passing (200), the first time the Buffs have recorded at least 200 in both since the second game of the 2005 season (versus New Mexico State). CU has a 32-2 record in such games since 1989. The 463 yards was a season best, topping the 380 against Texas Tech.



**IOWA STATE (4-8, 1-7)**  
End of Season

Dan McCarney ended his tenure at Iowa State as the winningest and longest-tenured head coach in school history with 56 wins and 141 games in 12 seasons. He led the Cyclones to five of their nine all-time bowl appearances.

Senior Ryan Kock rushed for a career-high 179 yards and two touchdowns in his final outing for ISU. He entered the game with 318 career yards.

Shawn Moorehead's game-saving sack on the final play against Missouri gave him 8.5 sacks for the season, an ISU single-season record. He closed his career with 18.5 sacks, also a school record.

Bret Meyer ended his junior campaign with a school-record 41 career touchdown passes and 7,979 yards of total offense (6th in Big 12).



**KANSAS (6-5, 3-4)**  
This Week: at Missouri  
Next: Bowl Eligible

Kansas forced a season-high six turnovers last week in its win over K-State and has caused at least one turnover in 41 of its last 45 games, including 18 of its last 21 contests.

Last Saturday's attendance of 51,821 is the largest crowd to witness a game at Memorial Stadium, surpassing the 51,750 set last season against Nebraska.

Big 12 Offensive Player of the Week Jon Cornish rushed for a career-high 201 yards vs. KSU.

Cornish recorded his seventh 100-yard rushing game of the season and 11th for his career. His 11 career 100-yard rushing games ties him with Gale Sayers (1962-64) for fourth on the KU list.



**KANSAS STATE (7-5, 4-4)**  
Next: Bowl Game

Josh Freeman finished the 2006 regular season with 1,651 yards passing, which are the 16th-most in K-State single-season history and the most by a freshman.

Freshman tight end Jeron Mastrud had a career-high five catches for a career-best 103 yards vs. KU, marking the first time he has gone over the century mark.

Leon Patton has three 100-yard rushing games on the season and has scored a rushing touchdown in five consecutive games.

Brandon Archer has 259 career tackles, good for 20th in the school record book.

Jeff Snodgrass' 16 field goals this season are the fifth-most in school history while his 26 career makes rank seventh.



**MISSOURI (7-4, 3-4)**  
This Week: Kansas  
Next: Bowl Game

Missouri and Coach Gary Pinkel have agreed to terms on a new five-year contract that will keep Pinkel on the Tiger sideline through the 2011 season.

Chase Daniel passed for over 300 yards last Saturday for the second time this season. He finished the day 29-of-44 for 310 yards. Daniel is second in the Big 12 with 2,841 yards on the season.

Jeff Wolfert has made all 37 of his PAT attempts this season and has hit 14 of 16 field goal attempts.

Missouri is second in the Big 12 in scoring defense, allowing 18.0 ppg. The Tigers are also second in pass defense, giving up 172.4 yards a game through the air.



**NEBRASKA (8-3, 5-2)**

**This Week:** Colorado  
**Next:** Big 12 Championship Game

The Huskers clinched the Big 12 North Division and will make their fourth appearance in the Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship (2-1), first since 1999.

Zac Taylor has 22 touchdown passes this season, setting a Nebraska record formerly held by Vince Ferragamo with 20 in 1976. He became NU's all-time passing leader with 5,193 career passing yards in two seasons. Taylor is 113 yards shy of his school record of 2,653 yards in a season set last year.

Senior defensive end Adam Carriker had six tackles, including two tackles for loss, in the win at Texas A&M. Carriker has 12 tackles for loss this season and 37 in his career, putting him in eighth place on Nebraska's career tackles for loss list.



**OKLAHOMA (9-2, 6-1)**

**This Week:** at Oklahoma State  
**Next:** Big 12 Championship or Bowl Game

Paul Thompson has 2,092 passing yards on the season, the eighth-best total in school history. His completion percentage is 61.4% as he tries to become just the third OU quarterback in the last 46 years to complete at least 60% of his passes in a season.

Chris Brown became the third Oklahoma player (Adrian Peterson, Allen Patrick) to rush for 100 yards this season when he rambled for 169 at Baylor. OU has had a 100-yard rusher in 10 of its 11 games to date.

Reggie Smith picked off two passes, returning one for a touchdown, in the win at Baylor to earn Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week.

Special Teams Player of the Week Juaquin Iglesias had an 88-yard kick off return for a touchdown against Baylor.



**OKLAHOMA STATE (6-5, 3-4)**

**This Week:** Oklahoma  
**Next:** Bowl Eligible

The Cowboys have scored 403 points this season making them only the fourth team in school history to score 400 points in a season (522 in 1988; 467 in 2003; 446 in 2002).

Junior wide receiver Adarius Bowman became the third wide receiver in OSU history to record 1,000 receiving yards in a season, joining Rashaun Woods and Hart Lee Dykes. Bowman has 51 catches for 1,051 yards on the year, with his 1,051 yards giving him the fourth best single-season total in school history.

With 120 yards on 22 carries last week, junior Dantrell Savage topped the 100-yard rushing mark for the fourth time this season (all coming in the last five games) and is now the Cowboys leading rusher on the season. Savage, who missed OSU's first two games with an injury, has rushed for 659 yards in 2006.



**TEXAS (9-2, 6-1)**

**This Week:** Texas A&M  
**Next:** Big 12 Championship or Bowl Game

Texas has held seven opponents this season to fewer than 50 yards rushing.

Michael Griffin's third-quarter punt block at Kansas State was the eighth of his career, putting him alone in second on the NCAA career list. He passed Tim Curry, Air Force (1996-98) and Barron Miles, Nebraska (1992-94).

Billy Pittman has four 100-yard receiving games in his career. He has caught at least one pass in 10 consecutive games and at least three passes in four of the last five games this season.

Limas Sweed's TD reception at K-State was his 11th of the season, putting him alone in second on the UT single-season list. It was the 16th of his career, tying him with B.J. Johnson (2000-03) and Mike Adams (1992-96) for second on the UT career list.



**TEXAS A&M (8-3, 4-3)**

**This Week:** at Texas  
**Next:** Bowl Game

A&M's three losses this season have been by a combined six points, including two one-point losses.

Jorvorskie Lane's 1-yard touchdown plunge in the fourth quarter against Nebraska was his 19th rushing TD of the season, tying the school record set by Joel Hunt in 1927. Lane has 28 career touchdown runs, tying Courtney Lewis (2003-06) and D'Andre Hardeman (1996-99) for ninth on the A&M chart.

Against Nebraska, Stephen McGee completed 18-of-31 passes for 244 yards, the second most passing yards of his career and the second most pass attempts. For the season, McGee has completed 170-of-274 passes (.621) for 2,060 yards, the ninth most season yards in school history. He is on track to break the school record for completion percentage of .607 set by Kevin Murray in 1986.



**TEXAS TECH (7-5, 4-4)**

**Next:** Bowl Game

Robert Johnson recorded the fifth 100-yard receiving game of his career and his fourth career multiple-touchdown game last week. He totaled 108 receiving yards on eight catches and hauled in two touchdowns.

Junior placekicker Alex Trlica moved past former running back Ricky Williams (1997-01) for third place on the all-time scoring list at Texas Tech. Trlica now has 263 total points in his Red Raider career. He has made all 161 PAT attempts in his career.

For the first time in school history, Texas Tech has two players with 10 or more touchdown receptions each – Joel Filani (12) and Robert Johnson (10).

Receiver L.A. Reed made his presence felt on special teams in the win over Oklahoma State with five tackles and a forced fumble.
