### 11th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

The 11th annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship takes place at Kansas City's Arrowhead Stadium on Saturday, Dec. 2, at 7:00 p.m. (CST) under the television cameras of ABC Sports.

General public tickets are available at all Ticketmaster outlets, by phone at (800) 676-5488 or online at [ticketmaster.com](http://ticketmaster.com). Group tickets and premium ticket packages are available through Arrowhead Stadium at (888) 992-4433.

Tickets are priced at \$80, \$70, \$60 and \$50, plus handling fee.

In the 10-year history of the event, there have been six different winners. All-time titlists include Texas (1996, 2005), Nebraska (1997, 1999), Texas A&M (1998), Oklahoma (2000, 2002, 2004), Colorado (2001) and Kansas State (2003).

### Big 12 BCS Success

The 2005 season marked the third straight and fifth time in the last six years that a Big 12 team played in the BCS National Championship game. Since the inception of the the BCS, the Big 12 is 2-3 in the National Championship game and leads all conferences with its five appearances. Texas (2005) and Oklahoma (2000) have won titles, while Nebraska (2001) and Oklahoma (2003, '04) were denied crowns.

### Division Races

Texas wins the South Division with a victory in its final regular-season game. Oklahoma claims the title by winning its two remaining games, coupled with a Texas loss. If both Texas and OU win its remaining games, or UT loses and Oklahoma splits, the Longhorns and Sooners would share the South Division crown, but UT holds the tie-breaker over Oklahoma by virtue of its head-to-head victory, and would play in the Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship game.

Nebraska has clinched the North Division title for the fourth time in league history. The Cornhuskers will make their first appearance in the Big 12 Championship game since 1999. All-time, NU is 2-1 in the Championship game.

### All-Conference Team

The AT&T Big 12 All-Conference team and individual award winners will be announced by the conference office on Tuesday, November 28.

### Big 12 Bowl Partners

Again this season, the Big 12 has eight bowl slots guaranteed. The Conference is partnered with nine bowls, with the the Gator Bowl and Sun Bowl taking a Big 12 team twice over a four-year period. In the two years in which the Gator does not select a Big 12 team, the Sun Bowl will. Following is the selection order:

- BCS - Fiesta
- Cotton
- Holiday
- Gator (when it selects a Big 12 team)
- Alamo
- Sun (when the Gator does not take a Big 12 team)
- Insight
- Independence
- Texas

### Bowl Eligibility

Heading into the final weeks of the regular-season the Big 12 finds itself with seven teams currently at or better than the NCAA minimum six-win threshold for bowl eligibility. When filling a conference's contracted bowl slots, six-win teams can only be selected provided there are no other teams with winning records available within the conference to fulfill its obligation(s). Teams with winning records must be selected to fill a conference's bowl obligations before six-win teams within the conference can be chosen. Six-win teams are only able to fill at-large spots in bowls outside of existing bowl agreements if there are no other teams with winning records available within Division I-A.

**BAYLOR (4-7, 3-4)**  
**This Week:** Oklahoma  
**End of Season**

Baylor has scored at least 21 points in six consecutive conference games, the longest such streak since a seven-game run in 1986.

Dominique Zeigler moved into second place on Baylor's career receptions list with 164. He moved into an eighth-place tie on BU's single-season receptions list with 54 to join Reggie Newhouse, Gerald McNeil and Lawrence Elkins as the only Bears to ever record 50-plus receptions in multiple seasons.

Trent Shelton moved into sole possession of 10th place on Baylor's single-season receptions list; he now has 51 receptions on the year.

Zeigler and Shelton became the first Bears teammates to both record 50-plus receptions in the same season.



**COLORADO (2-9, 2-5)**  
**This Week:** Idle  
**Next Week:** at Nebraska

Bernard Jackson completed 13-of-19 passes for a career-best 200 yards and two touchdowns vs. Iowa State. He finished the game with a career-best passer rating of 191.6, and rushed nine times for 69 yards and another TD. He accounted for 269 yards of total offense, 10 first downs and three scores.

PK Mason Crosby has 305 career points, the first Buff to eclipse the 300 point barrier. In field goal tries this season, his average make is 40.6 yards and average miss is from 51.8.

In the win over Iowa State, Colorado reached 200 yards in both rushing (263) and passing (200), the first time the Buffs have recorded at least 200 in both since the second game of the 2005 season (versus New Mexico State). CU has a 32-2 record in such games since 1989. The 463 yards was a season best, topping the 380 against Texas Tech.



**IOWA STATE (3-8, 0-7)**  
**This Week:** Missouri  
**End of Season**

After 12 years at the helm of the Iowa State football program, head coach Dan McCarney announced his resignation effective at the end of the season. McCarney ranks as the longest-tenured coach in the Big 12.

Bret Meyer's 21-yard TD pass to Jon Davis at Colorado was the 40th of his career, tying him with Todd Bandhauer (40, 1995-98) for the school record.

Bret Culbertson extended his PAT streak to 71 makes.

With 49 yards receiving last week, Jon Davis now has 1,397 career yards, which moved him into eighth place on the all-time ISU chart.



**KANSAS (5-5, 2-4)**  
**This Week:** Kansas State  
**Next Week:** at Missouri

The Jayhawks need one win to become bowl eligible for the second straight season. KU has never participated in back-to-back bowl games.

RB Jon Cornish leads the Big 12 and ranks ninth in the NCAA with an average of 113.0 rushing yards per game.

CB Aqib Talib leads the nation with an average of 2.62 pass breakups per game and is sixth in Division I-A with five interceptions.

Kansas has scored 58 points off 13 opponent miscues over the last four outings. The Jayhawks have scored 74 points off 22 takeaways for the season.



**KANSAS STATE (7-4, 4-3)**  
**This Week:** at Kansas  
**Next:** Bowl Game

With the win over Texas, K-State defeated a ranked opponent for the first time since knocking off No. 13 Oklahoma 35-7 in the 2003 Big 12 Championship Game. The last win at home against a ranked opponent was on Nov. 16, 2002, against No. 12 Nebraska, 49-13.

After 269 yards passing last Saturday, Josh Freeman set the K-State freshman passing mark. He is 41-of-57 for 520 yards and five touchdowns in his last two games.

Yamon Figurs now has 475 career yards on punt returns, which ranks sixth all-time in school history.

Ian Campbell has 11.5 sacks, tying the single-season school record. He also recovered two Longhorn fumbles on back-to-back Texas possessions during the third quarter.



**MISSOURI (7-3, 3-3)**  
**This Week:** at Iowa State  
**Next Week:** Kansas

Chase Daniel enters this week's game with the MU single season yardage record of 2,531 yards in 10 games. He is responsible for 15.00 points per game, good for third in the Big 12.

Tony Temple rushed for 99 yards on 18 carries vs. NU to improve his season total to 761. He averages 5.2 yards per carry.

William Franklin averages 17.24 yards per catch on his 46 receptions this year and numbers 79.3 yards per game.

Jeff Wolfert is 23rd in the nation in field goals, he has hit 13 of 15 on the year, including a career-long 54 yarder vs. Nebraska.

Missouri is second in the Big 12 in scoring defense allowing 17.7 points per game.



**NEBRASKA (8-3, 5-2)**

**This Week:** Idle  
**Next Week:** Colorado

The Huskers clinched the Big 12 North Division and will make their fourth appearance in the Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship (2-1) for the first time since 1999.

Zac Taylor has 22 touchdown passes this season, setting a Nebraska record formerly held by Vince Ferragamo with 20 in 1976. He became NU's all-time passing leader with 5,193 career passing yards in two seasons. Taylor is 113 yards shy of his school record of 2,653 yards in a season set last year.

Senior defensive end Adam Carriker had six tackles, including two tackles for loss, in the win at Texas A&M. Carriker has 12 tackles for loss this season and 37 in his career, putting him in eighth place on Nebraska's career tackles for loss list.



**OKLAHOMA (8-2, 5-1)**

**This Week:** at Baylor  
**Next Week:** at Oklahoma State

Malcolm Kelly tied the school record with 11 receptions in the win over Texas Tech. He had 11 grabs for 153 yards and one touchdown. The yardage figure ranks No. 8 at OU. Seven of Kelly's receptions resulted in first downs.

Against Texas Tech, Garrett Hartley made both of his field goal attempts and all four of his PAT tries despite playing on a sprained ankle that required him to wear a boot for most of the week. He has now made 17-of-18 field goals this season and all of his PAT attempts.

Rufus Alexander had seven tackles and a pass break-up to lead an OU defense that held the Red Raiders 10.4 points below their scoring average and 175 yards under their passing average.



**OKLAHOMA STATE (6-4, 3-3)**

**This Week:** at Texas Tech  
**Next Week:** Oklahoma

The Cowboys became bowl-eligible with their win last week.

Dantrell Savage led OSU with 116 rushing yards on 13 carries against Baylor. He averaged 8.9 yards per rush and now averages 7.81 yards per rush for the season -- the fourth best average in the country. He has three 100-yard games this season.

Perrish Cox had seven solo tackles against Baylor. He also intercepted a pass, broke up a pass and caused a fumble that was returned for a touchdown by Donovan Woods. In addition, he opened the game with a 57-yard kickoff return that set up the Cowboys' first score and had a 15-yard punt return in the win.

Bobby Reid moved into fourth place on OSU's single-season total offense chart. The sophomore quarterback has accounted for 2,195 yards of offense this season.



**TEXAS (9-2, 6-1)**

**This Week:** Idle  
**Next Week:** Texas A&M

Texas has held seven opponents this season to fewer than 50 yards rushing.

Michael Griffin's third-quarter punt block at Kansas State was the eighth of his career, putting him alone in second on the NCAA career list. He passed Tim Curry, Air Force (1996-98) and Barron Miles, Nebraska (1992-94).

Billy Pittman recorded the fourth 100-yard receiving game of his career. He has caught at least one pass in 10 consecutive games and at least three passes in four of the last five games this season.

Limas Sweed's TD reception at K-State was his 11th of the season, putting him alone in second on the UT single-season list. It was the 16th of his career, tying him with B.J. Johnson (2000-03) and Mike Adams (1992-96) for second on the UT career list.



**TEXAS A&M (8-3, 4-4)**

**This Week:** Idle  
**Next Week:** at Texas

A&M's three losses this season have been by a combined six points, including two one-point losses.

Jorvorskie Lane's 1-yard touchdown plunge in the fourth quarter against Nebraska was his 19th rushing TD of the season, tying the school record set by Joel Hunt in 1927. Lane has 28 career touchdown runs, tying Courtney Lewis (2003-06) and D'Andre Hardeman (1996-99) for ninth on the A&M chart.

Last Saturday against Nebraska, Stephen McGee completed 18-of-31 passes for 244 yards, the second most passing yards of his career and the second most pass attempts. For the season, McGee has completed 170-of-274 passes (.621) for 2,060 yards, the ninth most season yards in school history. He is on track to break the school record for completion percentage of .607 set by Kevin Murray in 1986.



**TEXAS TECH (6-5, 3-4)**

**This Week:** Oklahoma State  
**Next:** Bowl Game

Texas Tech has scored 83 points this season off turnovers, including 11 touchdowns and two field goals.

Robert Johnson's opening quarter touchdown reception against Oklahoma was his first since he scored the game-winning catch in the final seconds at Texas A&M on Sept. 30. He picked up his second touchdown of the game later in the first quarter.

Freshman wide receiver Adrian Reese caught a 28-yard pass at OU - marking his career-long reception and surpassing his entire season total of 21 yards coming into the game.

Senior cornerback Antonio Huffman picked up his first career interception return for a touchdown and his third career interception (first of the season).
