



## MID-EASTERN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE PLAYING AND PRACTICE SEASON REPORT

The Athletics Compliance Office shall be responsible for reviewing this form for accuracy and compliance with NCAA and MEAC regulations and submission to the Conference Office prior the deadline designated in the conference compliance calendar (Best practice: Compare with NCAA Compliance Assistant (Cai) to ensure accuracy). Any changes, additions or deletions to the attached competition schedule must be submitted to the Conference Office with the updated schedule and playing and practice season report approved by the Athletic Compliance Office.
