LOCKER ROOMS

Each team will be assigned a specific locker room that it will use throughout the tournament. Each team's name/logo will be on the outside of its assigned locker room and on the wall visible from the hallway leading to the locker rooms. Shower towels will be made available by request only. BENCH ASSIGNMENTS

The designated home team will wear white uniforms and occupy the bench on the southeast side of the court (to the right if you are facing the scorer's table at mid-court). The designated visiting team will wear dark uniforms and occupy the bench on the northeast side of the court (to the left if you are facing the scorer's table at mid-court).

ATHLETIC TRAINING ROOM

The UCSD Athletic Training room is located in RIMAC. The Athletic Training room will be available for use by visiting teams during games and practices. Water, cups, ice bags and emergency equipment will be provided. Team physicians will be on site or on call during practices and games. Specific arrangements should be made through Allison Pastor.
