QUICKIE NOTES

•N.C. A&T will open their 47th MEAC tournament by playing Maryland Eastern Shore for the third time this season.

•The first meeting saw the Hawks hit 16 3-pointers in Greensboro on Jan. 9. Nine of those 3-pointers were made by Ryan Andino who had 31 points. Bakari Copeland added 26 in the 99-88 win.

•On Feb. 20, the game went into triple overtime before the Aggies dropped a 106-95 decision. Aggies guard Eliel Gonzalez had a career-high 23 points and Sam Hunt added 19.

•Once again Copeland played big for the Hawks with 29 points. Hawks guard Logan McIntosh has been the X factor in both games, averaging 12.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 7.5 assists in the two games.

•North Carolina A&T won the MEAC title in 2013 by beating Morgan State 57-54 on March 16, 2013. The Aggies have not won a tournament game since. They are 6-9 in the MEAC tourney over the last 10 years.

•Before beating NCCU, the Aggies had lost 15 straight conference games. The Aggies longest losing streak within the conference remains at 17. The Aggies lost their final MEAC game of the 2001-02 season before losing 16 straight MEAC games during the 2002-03 season.

•The Aggies finally got a win that season on March 3, 2003 over Norfolk State, 61-54.

NCCU was defeated on March 2 as the 2016-17 team avoided being the team to go the longest without a Division I win since the Aggies became a Division I team in 1978.

• Aggies guard Sam Hunt has made 59 of his last 60 free throws and at one time this season he hit 51 straight free throws. He shoots 94.8 percent from the line this season.

•Including his time at Jacksonville U, Hunt is a 90.8 percent FT shooter as a collegiate player. He is a 92.1 percent FT shooter at A&T.

WHAT'S NEXT FOR THE AGGIES

- N.C. A&T will begin play in the MEAC tournament on March 6. The Aggies will be seeking their 16th tournament title.
- N.C. A&T will face Maryland Eastern Shore to open the 2017 MEAC Men's Basketball Championship Tournament two weeks after the two teams played in a triple overtime thriller.

If the Aggies win...

- They will end a three-game losing streak in the MEAC tournament. The Aggies have not won a MEAC tournament game since winning the championship game back in 2013.
- They will avoid losing to Maryland Eastern Shore three times in one regular season for the first time in program history. In fact, the Aggies have never lost to the Hawks in the MEAC tournament, winning the first five matchups.
- They will put together their first two-game winning streak of the season. The only other seasons where the Aggies did not have a two-game winning streak came during the 2002-03 season and the 2003-04 season.
- They will advance to face two-time defending MEAC champion Hampton 8 p.m., Thursday. It would be the second meeting between the two teams this season after the Pirates defeated the Aggies 68-53 in Hampton, Va., on Jan. 4.

AGGIES TAKE ON A LOCAL FEEL

- North Carolina A&T has three players on its roster who played high school basketball at a Piedmont high school.
- Sam Hunt played his first season for the Aggies last season after transferring in from Jacksonville University. Hunt played at Dudley High School which is 1.5 miles from North Carolina A&T's campus, where he averaged 20.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists as a senior.
- Freshman Raymon Pratt played his high school basketball at Smith High School which is eight miles from N.C. A&T. Pratt averaged 21.5 points, 9.3 rebounds, 2.7 assists and 1.4 steals per game as a senior.
- Graduate Aaron Scales played at Cleveland State before transferring to N.C. A&T as a graduate. Scales played his senior year at American Basketball Institute. Before that he averaged 9.3 points and 9.7 rebounds at High Point Christian.

GONZALEZ MAKES HIS WAY TO N.C. A&T

- Eliel Gonzalez is a Puerto Rican native who moved to Florida to play high school basketball.
- Gonzalez signed with Hofstra out of high school where he played one season after redshirting his first season.
- Gonzalez was playing behind a group of talented point guards including Juan'ya Green who averaged 36.4 minutes per game. During the 2014-15 season, he averaged 4.1 minutes in 19 games played.
- Gonzalez decided to transfer to junior college Mississippi Gulf Coast. There, his playing time increased and he averaged 7.9 points, 2.5 rebounds and 2.4 assists per game while shooting 42.2 percent from 3-point range.
- Gonzalez then signed with N.C. A&T where he has found a starting position as an Aggie because of his good court vision and his ability to take care of the basketball as the Aggies point guard. Gonzalez has two years of eligibility.

A&T BY THE NUMBERS...

ON THE HUNT FOR MEAC GLORY

• The Aggies fortunes this year ride on the shooting stroke of junior guard Sam Hunt.

• Hunt was the Aggies only preseason all-conference selection, earning first-team honors from the MEAC. He led the Aggies in scoring at 15.4 points per game and was eighth in the conference.

• Hunt is also one of the best free throw shooters in the nation, shooting 94.8 percent this season and 92.1 percent for his career.

• Hunt has scored in double figures 40 times in his career and has 143 career 3-pointers. He is averaging 14.8 points per game in 60 games played as an Aggie.

Also in his career, he is averaging 33.8 minutes per game.

EXPERIENCED PLAYERS

• N.C. A&T has no four-year seniors on the roster, but they do have two four-year players.

• Redshirt juniors Nick Reese and James Whitaker arrived at N.C. A&T a year after the Aggies lost seven seniors off of a MEAC tournament championship team.

• Those seven seniors were replaced by seven freshmen, but then coach Cy Alexander decided not to suit all seven freshmen that season.

• The two players he decided to sit for the 2013-14 season were Reese and Whitaker.

• They now provide much needed experience for the Aggies in their fourth season working with Jay Joyner who used to be the associate head coach at N.C.

• Reese and Whitaker are now in their fourth season as contributors to the program with Whitaker grabbing 15 rebounds earlier this season against Greensboro College.

• Whitaker has played in 78 games with 11 starts, while Reese has played in 56 games with six starts.

TRANSFERABLE PLAYERS

- N.C. A&T added seven transfers during the offseason to bring the total number of transfers on the roster to nine. Nine out of the 17 players associated with N.C. A&T men's basketball team are transfers.
- Three of the Aggie transfers are sitting out this season. Wagner transfers Aaren Edmead and Japhet Kadji will play next season along with Oakland University transfer Femi Olujobi.
- Sam Hunt was a Division I transfer from Jacksonville two seasons ago.
- Four of the Aggie transfers are from the junior college ranks. Senior Mike Owona came over last season from Northwest Kansas Tech, while Davaris McGowens (Gulf Coast State), Eliel Gonzalez (Mississippi Gulf Coast) and Donte Watson (Co-Lin) came over this season.
- The other transfer is graduate Aaron Scales who played previously at Cleveland State, graduated early, and will play his final year of eligibility at N.C. A&T.

AGGIES LOSE THEIR KEYES

- For three years, Denzel Keyes served as the Aggies top wide receiver in football on a conference championship team and as its power forward on the basketball court.
- In 2015-16, Keyes led the football team in receiving before leading the men's basketball team in rebounding (7.2).
- Keyes played football in 2016, helping the Aggies to a 9-3 mark and an appearance in the NCAA FCS playoffs. Even though he has one year of eligibility left in basketball he will turn his focus to an attempt at a professional football career and forego his last season of hoops.
- As a football player, Keyes ended his career as the Aggies all-time leader in touchdown receptions with 24.
- He is a two-time All-MEAC second-team selection who tied the school's single-season touchdown receptions record with 10.
- As a basketball player, he played in 70 games with 24 starts and averaged 4.7 points and 4.0 rebounds in his career. In all, Keyes played in 111 athletic contests for the N.C. A&T Department of Athletics over four years.

FRESHMAN GUARDS OF THE FUTURE

- North Carolina A&T head coach Jay Joyner is high on his three of his freshman guards, looking at all three as steals who will eventually contribute to the program.
- Pratt is a do-it all player who averaged 21.5 points, 9.3 rebounds, 2.7 assists and 1.4 steals per game as a senior at Smith High School. He was also a 1,000-point scorer for the Golden Eagles. He scored 18 points to lead the Golden Eagles to the Metro 4-A conference championship.
- Joyner says Pratt is a perfect defensive fit for the Aggies because he has a build that will allow him to guard point guards, power forwards and wings.
- Mullins will hope to one day take over at point guard for the Aggies. Joyner was surprised someone with his upside was not signed. Mullins is another guard who could be good for the Aggies defensively with his long arms and athleticism. He averaged 24.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game as a senior at Nash Central. He also shot 44 percent from 3-point range.
- Dotson will likely redshirt this season for the Aggies. Dotson gives the Aggies a speedy guard who loves to attack the basket. He is also a good passer. He attended Providence High School before the 2015-16 when he played for Moravian Prep in Lenoir, N.C. Dotson averaged 10.0 points and 6.0 assists at Moravian Prep but was hampered by a hand injury.
- As a senior at Providence, he averaged 15.4 points and 3.3 assists. Joyner called him an underrated player for his skill set.

JOYNER JOINS THE FIGHT AGAINST CANCER

- Coaches from N.C. A&T, Elon, UNC Greensboro and High Point University have teamed up the last two seasons to raise awareness and support for fighting cancer.
- Each local coach will team up with a local Subway near their respective schools in January and February to launch a special Coaches vs. Cancer campaign.
- N.C. A&T head coach Jay Joyner participated on Jan. 17 at noon at the 1046 Summit Avenue Subway restaurant.

• Joyner became a sandwich artist for an hour in order to combat cancer. Donations in any amount can be made at the checkout of Triad-area Subways with 100 percent of the proceeds going to the Coaches vs. Cancer program.

ON THE ROAD WITH A&T

- The Aggies are still looking for their first non-conference road win since Jan. 5, 2013 when they defeated Georgia Southern.
- It is a streak of 35 straight games without beating a non-conference foe on the road. The Aggies did snap their 15-game road losing streak with their win at N.C. Central on Feb. 6, 2016.

SOPHOMORES STILL REMAIN

- N.C. A&T had its only true freshman transfer during the offseason in Deion James.
- That would have left the Aggies without a sophomore class, but the Aggies had Amari Hamilton sit out last season which makes him a redshirt sophomore.
- They also had freshman Martin Jones II walk-on midway through last season to create another sophomore for the 2016-17. Therefore instead of having a missing class, the Aggies have two guards with good outside touches over the next three seasons.

LAST SEASON WITH N.C. A&T

- Sam Hunt, James Whitaker and Nick Reese are all likely playing their last seasons with N.C. A&T even though each of them have one year of eligibility remaining.
- Hunt transferred to A&T after one season with Jacksonville University. Per NCAA rules, Hunt had to sit out one season before playing. He then played two seasons with the Aggies and in the process he marched toward his degree and plans on graduating in May.
- He, therefore, is eligible to transfer as a graduate without sitting out.
- Both Whitaker and Reese sat out their true freshman seasons at N.C. A&T, so they are seniors in the classroom and juniors on the court. They too may have the option of transferring without having to sit out as graduates.
- All three men were honored on Senior Day at N.C. A&T.

HEAD COACH JAY JOYNER



- He is the Aggies chief recruiter and was head coach Cy Alexander's No. 1 assistant before taking over as the interim head coach on Jan. 29, 2016.
- N.C. A&T Director of Athletics Earl Hilton named Joyner the permanent head coach on March 6, 2016 before a MEAC tournament game against Coppin State.
- Joyner went 5-5 in his interim role including a 5-3 mark in the conference that included two wins over arch-rival N.C. A&T.
- He was the head coach at Columbia State Junior College.
- He led the Chargers to a 61-23 and two Tennessee Community College Athletic Association regular-season titles.

• Joyner played for former Aggies head coach Cy Alexander, having played for him as a student-athlete from 1993-96. He worked for him as a professional and Alexander served on Joyner's staff as an assistant men's basketball coach at Columbia State Community College during the 2011-12 season. Their time together has produced championships and postseason appearances, including the 2013 MEAC tournament title the two won together.

• In 2012, the Charges made their first national tournament appearance in 34 years. The 2011-12 team went 23-8 and finished the season ranked sixth in the nation. Joyner earned the 2011-12 National Junior College Athletic Association District 7 Coach of the Year honor and was named the TCCAA Coach of the Year in 2010 and '12.

• Joyner spent the 2008-2009 season as an assistant coach for the Cumberland University men's basketball program, a National Association Intercollegiate Athletics institution, in Lebanon, Tenn. He helped the Bulldogs to an NAIA National Championship Tournament appearance with a 26-6 record. He developed the post players, coordinated all recruiting, and scouted each opponent. He was also responsible for implementing the team's game plan.
