QUICKIE NOTES

- ▶ N.C. A&T had one of the best one-year turnarounds in NCAA history last season. The Aggies went from three wins in 2016-17 to 20 wins in 2017-18. It was one game shy of the biggest one-year improvement in NCAA history.
- ▶ A&T improved by 17 games while UTEP improved by 18 games in 2003-04.
- ▶ A year ago, the Aggies put together their 17th 20-win season in school history. It was just the Aggies third 20-win season in the past 30 years (1987-88, 2012-13, 2017-18).
- ▶ N.C. A&T was invited to the College Insider.com Tournament last season after being eliminated in the MEAC tournament semifinals last season. It was the Aggies first postseason appearance since reaching the NCAA tournament in 2013.
- ▶ The Aggies also boasted an undefeated season at home last season (12-0), their first undefeated season at home since the 1987-88 season.
- ▶ Joyner was named MEAC coach of the year following the Aggies remarkable turnaround. He was the first Aggies coach to win the award since Don Cobett did it in 1988.

- ▶ A&T comes into the game as one of the best 3-point shooting teams in the MEAC. The Aggies have made 135 3-pointers this season.
- ▶ A&T ranks ninth in the nation and first in the MEAC 3-point field goal percentage at 39.9 percent.
- ▶ A&T has hit 28 3-pointers in their last two games including 14 at Delaware State on Saturday.
- ▶ The Aggies are led by Terry Harris from 3-point range. Harris is 43-for-88 from 3-point range (.489) which is the best percentage in the conference and the sixth-best in the nation. Harris is third in the MEAC in 3-pointers made.
- ▶ A&T leads the conference and ranks 35th in the nation in field goal shooting (.484). A&T has two players shooting better than 60 percent in guard Milik Gantz (.612) and center Ibrahim Sylla (.638). Sylla and Gantz are 1,2 in field goal percentage in the MEAC.
- ▶ Sophomore Kameron Langley continues to excel as the Aggies point guard. He leads the conference in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.71) and assists. During his career, Langley has 282 assists against only 114 turnovers.

A&T FINISHES OFF ROAD TRIP AT MDES

- ▶ A&T will end their three-game road trip to open the conferece season with a match-up at the Maryland Eastern Shore Hawks
- ▶ The Aggies are 2-0 during the road trip thus far with wins over S.C. State and Delaware State.
- ▶ The Aggies will face an old nemesis in head coach Clifford Reed. Reed was the head coach at Bethune-Cookman from 2001-2011.
- ▶ Reed is the interim head coach at MDES. Reed is 9-6 all-time against the Aggies.He has also faced the Aggies as an assistant at Savannah State and Georgia Southern.
- ▶ Tyler Jones had two big games against the Aggies last season. He had 18 points on 7-for-12 shooting in Greensboro and 21 points on 8-for-14 in Princess Anne, Md.

IF THE AGGIES WIN...

- ▶ They will have their second straight 3-0 start in the MEAC. The Aggies have not started 2-0 in back-to-back seasons since the 1980-81, 1981-82 seasons.
- ▶ It will be their third straight win over MDES overall and their secod straight win at the Hytche Center.
- ▶ It will be the Aggies third straight conference win on the road. That has not happened since the 2011-12 season when the A&T beat Howard, Morgan State and Coppin State in three consecutive road MEAC games.
- ▶ It will be A&T's fifth road win this season matching their total from last season.

THE LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ The Aggies hit 14 3-pointers on their way to a 93-70 win over Delaware State at Memorial Hall.
- ▶ Graduate forward Terry Harris led the Aggies with 25 points on 7-for-11 shooting from 3-point range. Qua Copeland added 22 points on 6-for-8 shooting from three.
- ▶ It was the Aggies most lopsided win over the Hornets since a 69-55 win at Corbett Sports Center in 2000. It was the most lopsided win at Memorial Hall since the Aggies beat the Hornets 94-63 in 1988.
- ▶ The Aggies have now won five straight over DSU.

ONE YEAR WONDERS

- ▶ A&T is one of 13 Division I teams who have two or fewer players on their roster who have spent less than two years on the roster.
- ▶ The only player who has been with the Aggies more than two years is fifth-year guard Amari Hamilton.
- ▶ There are only five players back from last season's 20-win team and only two of those players are sophomores in Kameron Langley and D'Andre Johnson.
- ▶ The other two players other than Hamilton are junior college transfer and senior Milik Gantz and Division I transfer and senior Aaren Edmead.
- ▶ One of the Aggies earlier opponents, Mount St. Mary's, had only one player on the roster with more than two years experience.

ROSTER TRANSFORMERS

- ▶ Recruiting has changed for the Aggies over the past two seasons. The Aggies have nine newcomers this season and had 10 newcomers last season.
- ▶ The large turnover is due in part to head coach Jay Joyner coaching his first full season at N.C. A&T in 2016-17 which led to a lot of attrition. After the 2017-18 the Aggies lost their leading scorer in Femi Olujobi. After graduating from N.C. A&T, he transferred to Depaul.
- ▶ The Aggies also lost several others before their eligibility was finished including Kwei Lartey, Raymon Pratt and Japhet Kadji.
- ▶ In addition, the Aggies lost top 3-pointer shooter Devonte Boykins who played with the Aggies one season after transferring from Georgia Southern as a graduate transfer. They also third-team All-MEC talents Denzel Keyes and Davaris McGowens. Seniors Donte Watson and Austin Williams left after graduating.
- ▶ It led head coach Jay Joyner to have to add to his roster quickly. Joyner added two junior college transfers (Ronald Jackson and Andre Jackson), three graduate transfers (Terry Harris, Nelson Nweke and Ibrahim Sylla), one Division I transfer (Qua Copeland) and three freshmen (Ed Ferguson, Tyrone Lyons and Travon Mayo).

A&T BY THE NUMBERS...

- 4** — It is the number of New Yorkers the Aggies have on the roster this season. It matches the number of North Carolinians that are on the roster as well. Head coach Jay Joyner is also from New York.
- 5** — It is the number of players on the Aggies current roster who already have their undergraduate degrees including Aaren Edmead, Amari Hamilton, Terry Harris, Nelson Nweke and Ibrahim Sylla.
- 7** — It is the number of seasons since the Aggies last had a first-team All-MEAC performer. Thomas Coleman earned first-team honors during the 2010-11 season.
- 7** — It is the number of career 1,000-point scorers the Aggies have secured since the 2008-09 season. Players include Steven Rush, Adrian Powell, Thomas Coleman, Bruce Beckford, Nic Simpson and Lamont Middleton.

▶ N.C. A&T head coach and New York native, has brought a New York/Big Apple type appeal to the N.C. A&T roster.

▶ Last year the Aggies had four players and three coaches from the state of New York.

▶ This season the Aggies have four players again from the state of New York and one coach, Joyner from the area.

▶ From last season's team the Aggies lost New Yorkers Austin Williams, Myles Patten and Femi Olujobi.

▶ Deer Park, N.Y., native Aaron Edmead did return this season and he was joined by Amityville native Tyrone Lyons as a freshman. Graduate transfer Terry Harris also joined the Aggies out of Dix Hills, N.Y. and graduate transfer Ibrahim Sylla is out of Harlem, N.Y.
▶ The Aggies have only four players from North Carolina in Amari Hamilton, Andre Jackson, Kameron Langley and Travon Mayo.

JOYNER MAKES GREAT JOURNEY TO COACH OF THE YEAR

▶ N.C. A&T head coach Jay Joyner found himself in a difficult situation in 2015-16.

▶ He was asked to take over for his mentor Cy Alexander mid season after Alexander retired from coaching with only nine regular-season games remaining.

▶ Joyner, who had never been a head coach on the Division I level, took over a five-win team and led them to a 5-4 finish in the regular-season before losing in the MEAC tournament.

▶ Joyner was given the head coaching job permanently before the start of the 2016 MEAC tournament. The Aggies then returned for the 2016-17 season and with a totally different team than the year before, the Aggies went just 3-29 on the season.

▶ Joyner lost even more players from that team but managed to reload with Division I and junior college transfers and won coach of the year in 2017-18.

AGGIES MOURN THE LOSS OF LEGENDARY COACH DON CORBETT

▶ Don Corbett, the legendary North Carolina A&T men's basketball coach who led the Aggies to seven Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference tournament championships over 14 seasons, died of cancer over the summer.

▶ Corbett's seven tournament conference titles occurred consecutively from 1982-88. The mark is still tied with the University of Kentucky for the longest such streak in NCAA Division I history (1944-50). Corbett became the Aggies head coach in 1979 as the successor to Gene Littles.

▶ He went 9-19 his first season and then proceeded to run off eight straight winning seasons and 11 altogether from 1979-93. Also in that span, Corbett put together six 20-win seasons, won the MEAC regular-season seven times and won the MEAC tournament and regular-season titles in the same year five times. Corbett led his Aggies to seven NCAA appearances and one NIT showing.

▶ The Aggies won a school-record 26 games by going 26-3 overall with a 16-0 mark in the MEAC in 1987-88. They advanced to the NCAA tournament where they nearly pulled off an upset at the Dean Dome against a talented Syracuse team.

▶ Corbett won MEAC coach of the year six times and an Aggie won MEAC player of the year six times during his tenure. He coached at Lincoln for eight years finishing with a 159-59 record. His teams finished either first or second in the Missouri Intercollegiate Athletic Association (MIAA) every year and his 1977-78 team made the NCAA Division II Elite Eight. He compiled a 159-59 record. He is still the school's all-time winningest basketball coach.

▶ Corbett finished his career at N.C. A&T 254-145. He had 415 overall coaching victories. In 2006, N.C. A&T named the basketball court for him and another legendary Aggies basketball coach, Cal Irvin. His son Don Corbett played for him at A&T and his son Darren is a former assistant coach at A&T.

▶



THE LANGLEY BROTHERS

▶ Kameron Langley is one of the best point guards in the MEAC. Langley is second in the MEAC and 13th in the nation in assists at 6.7 per game. In two years, Langley already has 257 assists in 47 games played.

▶ But Langley is not the only college basketball player in his family. Three other Langley brothers occupy the court in college hoops in Greensboro other than Langley. He will likely square off against all his brothers at some point in his career.

▶ Earlier this season, Langley played against his older brother Keyford Langley of Division III Greensboro College. Keyford, who is also a point guard, finished with 14 points, five rebounds and eight assists with only one turnover in the Aggies 92-67 win.

▶ For his part, Kameron, had eight points, seven assists and two steals.

▶ Two other Langley brothers will come into the fold next season when twins Keyshaun and Kobe Langley suit up for the UNC Greensboro Spartans next season.

▶ The Aggies and the Spartans will play next season at the Greensboro Coliseum.

HAMILTON BRINGS EXPERIENCE

▶ Amari Hamilton is the only Aggie who has been with head coach Jay Joyner through his entire tenure starting in 2015-16 when Joyner took over on an interim basis in late January.

▶ Hamilton has played in a team-high 83 games with 13 starts. He has scored 381 points over that period with 63 assists, 97 rebounds and he has made 71 3-pointers.

▶ He graduated from N.C. A&T last May with a degree in accounting.

NORTH CAROLINA A&T IS THE SCHOOL OF CHAMPIONS

▶ During the 2017-18 school year the Aggies claimed a large amount of MEAC regular-season titles including football, women's basketball, bowling and baseball.

▶ The Aggies also collected MEAC tournament titles in women's basketball, bowling and baseball.

▶ The Aggies also captured the men's and women's 2018 MEAC indoor track and field titles before the men also captured the 2018 MEAC outdoor title while the women finished second.

▶ In fact, the Aggies men's indoor track team has captured the last two titles while the women have done the same. The men have also won the last two MEAC outdoor titles.

▶ The Aggies football team also won the HBCU national championship while women's basketball, bowling and baseball earned NCAA tournament bids with bowling earning a No. 6 seed out of 10 teams.

▶ The Aggies are already off to a good start this year with the football team capturing their fourth MEAC title in five years.

▶ The football team also won its third HBCU title in four years when they beat Alcorn State 24-22 on Dec. 15.

▶ The Aggies men's cross country team won its first MEAC title in 35 years when they claimed the title back in October.

▶ A&T's volleyball team reached the MEAC title match for the first time in 13 years before losing to Howard in Washington, D.C. The men's basketball team won 20 games last season for the first time in five years.

HEAD COACH JAY JOYNER

Jay Joyner was announced as the head men's basketball coach at North Carolina A&T hours before the Aggies faced Coppin State in a Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference Basketball Championship Tournament game on March 7, 2016. Joyner was named interim head coach weeks earlier on Jan. 29, 2016 after the resignation of Cy Alexander.

Under Joyner, the Aggies closed out the 2015-16 regular season with a 5-4 record overall and a 5-3 mark in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference. After a tough season in his first full season as the Aggies head coach, Joyner spearheaded one of the best turnarounds in Division I history.

For his efforts, he became the first N.C. A&T men's basketball coach to win MEAC coach of the year since Don Corbett did it after the 1987-88 season. He was also named the National Association Basketball Coaches District 15 coach of the year.

The Aggies improved 17 games from the 2016-17 season to the 2017-18 season coming one game shy of tying UTEP's 18-game improvement in 2003-04. The Aggies finished 20-15 (.571) in 2017-18 marking the Aggies first 20-win season in five years and just the third in the past 30 years. The Aggies also put together their best winning percentage since the 1991-92 season. Their 18 regular-season wins were the most since '91-92.

Joyner led the Aggies to their first MEAC tournament win in five seasons when the Aggies won twice in the 2017-18 conference tournament. N.C. A&T's run to the semifinals was just the school's fourth semifinal appearance in 20 seasons. Their No. 4 seed in the tournament was the school's highest seeding since 2009. Also in 2017-18, Joyner led the Aggies to their first undefeated season at home in 30 seasons as the Aggies went 12-0 at Corbett Sports Center.

Key recruits such as Femi Olujobi and Kameron Langley were key in the Aggies resurgence. Olujobi was a second-team All-MEAC selection after leading the nation in scoring over the first four weeks of the 2017-18 season. Langley was named to the conference's all-rookie team after leading the MEAC in assist-to-turnover ratio and steals. The 2017-18 Aggies broke the school's season record for points (2,623).

Before becoming N.C. A&T's head coach, Joyner furthered his longtime

relationship with Alexander as he served as the Aggies associate head coach (2012-16) under Alexander. Previously Joyner had played for Alexander as a student-athlete at S.C. State. He also worked with Alexander as an assistant prior to N.C. A&T. Alexander even served on Joyner's staff at Columbia State Community College.

As the Aggies associate head coach, Joyner took the lead in the Aggies recruiting efforts. In his first season with the Aggies program, the Aggies won the MEAC title, won its first-ever NCAA tournament game and won 20 games for the first time in 25 years. Before coming to Greensboro, Joyner spent three seasons as the head men's basketball coach at Columbia State Community College, a two-year school in Middle Tennessee. Joyner led the Chargers to a 61-23 record and two Tennessee Community College Athletic Association regular-season titles.

In 2012, the Charges made their first national tournament appearance in 34 years. The 2011-12 team went 23-8 and finished the season ranked sixth in the nation. Joyner earned the 2011-12 National Junior College Athletic Association District 7 Coach of the Year honor and was named the TCCAA Coach of the Year in 2010 and '12.

Joyner spent the 2008-2009 season as an assistant coach for the Cumberland University men's basketball program, a National Association Intercollegiate Athletics institution, in Lebanon, Tenn. He helped the Bulldogs to an NAIA National Championship Tournament appearance with a 26-6 record.

Prior to finding success in Tennessee, Joyner gained experience working in the Big East. Joyner served as the director of player development for Rutgers University (2006-08), and spent two seasons developing and managing the Scarlet Knights' mentoring program. He worked with each student-athlete to help enhance their athletic performance, handled NCAA compliance documentation for student-athletes, served as the campus liaison for recruits and assisted with scheduling.

His coaching career began in Tennessee, where he served as the assistant coach at Columbia State Community College for the 2005-06 season, helping guide the Chargers to the conference championship game under head coach Malcolm Montgomery.

Joyner got his professional start in athletics in 2003, where he served as the administrative assistant/assistant strength coach for the men's basketball program at Tennessee State under Alexander. Before making the jump to collegiate athletics, Joyner was an assistant boys basketball coach at Centennial High School in Franklin, Tenn., for the 2002-03 season.

Joyner's familiarity with the Aggies comes from his playing career with S.C. State from 1993-96. He was part of the Bulldogs' 1995-96 championship team under Alexander. After leaving S.C. State, he competed professionally overseas. Joyner holds a bachelor's degree in physical education from Middle Tennessee State. He is a native of Amityville, N.Y. He and his wife have three children.
