A&T: A&T could have been out of contention for the Celebration Bowl on Nov. 3 if Florida A&M defeats Howard in Washington, D.C. They didn't and it kept the Aggies alive to win their final four games to clinch their fourth MEAC title in five years and their third bowl bid in four years.

A&T Coach Sam Washington:

(MVSU '82) is off to a 9-2 (.818) start to his head coaching career. It took Rod Broadway a season to get five wins. It took Bill Hayes two seasons to get five wins. If the Aggies win, Washington will tie George Small (2003) for the most wins by a first-year A&T head coach at 10. It will be the first time a first-year Aggie head coach has won a national title.

Alcorn State: Alcorn State returns to the Celebration Bowl after losing to the Aggies in the inaugural bowl, 41-34. The 2018 edition of the Braves features one of the best running games in the country. They're eighth in the nation in rushing and first in the SWAC at 282.3 rushing yards per game. The Braves have only lost to one FCS school this season.

Alcorn Coach Fred McNair: Fred McNair is in his third season with the Braves. The third time was the charm for McNair. After leading the Braves to the SWAC championship game each of his first two seasons, McNair won the SWAC title in his third with a SWAC championship game win over Southern. McNair has a career 21-14 record.

AGGIES-BRAVES CELEBRATION BOWL REMATCH IS FORTHCOMING

- ▶ The Aggies and Alcorn State will battle each other for the HBCU national title for the second time in four years.
- ▶ A&T defeated the Braves 41-34 behind 295 rushing yards from current Chicago Bear Tarik Cohen on Dec. 19, 2015. It was the third-best rushing performance in school history.
- ▶ The Aggies have four starters returning from the 2015 game including left tackle Marcus Pettiford, left guard Micah Shaw, wide receiver Malik Wilson and linebacker Deion Jones.
- ▶ Five other current Aggies also played in that game including quarterback Kyliil Carter, cornerback Timadre Abram, rover Jamaal Darden, linebacker Julius Reynolds and fullback William Hollingsworth.
- ▶ In fact, the 2015 Celebration Bowl marked Micah Shaw's first career start. He would not start another game until 2018 on his way to MEAC offensive lineman of the year honors.
- ▶ The Aggies senior class comes into the game with 40-7 with three MEAC titles, two Celebration Bowl wins and two HBCU national championships. Last season's senior class had 40 wins, therefore, the 2018 senior class is only one win away from breaking that mark.
- ▶ The road has not been a bad place for the Aggies. The Aggies have won 11 straight true road games and their last 13 games away from BB&T Stadium. The Aggies have not lost two straight games since losing at NCCU and at Richmond at the end of the 2016 season.
- ▶ The Aggies have appeared in the NCAA FCS playoffs five times with a 1-5 record. The Aggies will be making their eighth bowl appearance. The Aggies bowl games occurred in 1942 (Flower Bowl), 1948 (Vulcan Bowl), 1978 (Gold Bowl), 1980 (Gold Bowl), 1991 (Heritage Bowl), 2015 (Celebration Bowl), 2017 (Celebration Bowl) and 2018 (Celebration Bowl).
- ▶ The Aggies are coming off a 45-0 win over archrival N.C. Central where they had more points than the Eagles had total yards. The Aggies held NCCU to minus-21 yards rushing. Sam Washington took over the Aggies defense in 2011 as their defensive coordinator. The NCCU marked the sixth time since 2011 the Aggies have held a team to negative yards rushing.
- ▶ The Aggies have held opponents to under 50 yards rushing 24 times in 92 games played since the 2011 season.

48 — The Aggies have been ranked nationally ranked 48 straight weeks in the FCS Coaches Poll. The Aggies have been ranked in the Box-ToRow Black College Football poll 68 straight weeks. In 41 of those weeks, the Aggies have been ranked No. 1.

52 — It is the number of games the Aggies have gone without being shutout. A&T was last shutout on Oct. 4, 2014.

54 — It is the number of times since Sam Washington came to A&T in 2011 that A&T has held a team under 100 yards rushing. A&T has played 92 games with Washington, 81 with him as the defensive coordinator and 11 with him as head coach. A&T has held 42 teams under 80 yards rushing in the last eight years.

THE FOUR HORSEMEN

- ▶ There have been four main targets at wide receiver for A&T quarterbacks this season.
- ▶ Three of the main targets are scheduled to return next season in juniors Elijah Bell and Ron Hunt and sophomore Zachary Leslie.
- ▶ Senior Malik Wilson is the fourth member of the Aggies four horsemen.
- ▶ Each receiver has 20-plus catches this season led by Leslie's 44 receptions for 557 yards and eight touchdowns. Bell has 42 receptions, 473 yards and five touchdowns, Wilson has 32 receptions for 372 yards and three touchdowns and Hunt has 21 catches for 334 yards and two touchdowns.
- ▶ Leslie and Bell lead the team in targets with 76 apiece. Wilson has been targeted 48 times and Hunt has 37 targets.
- ▶ Leslie and Bell have two 100-yard games apiece. Wilson had 107 yards receiving against DSU on Oct. 6. Hunt's best game was a 7-reception, 90-yard game against GWU on Sept. 8.

CALLING DR. REYNOLDS

- ▶ Aggies linebacker and team captain Julius Reynolds has already graduated and is seeking a master's degree.
- ▶ He is also trying to head to medical school having already applied to South Florida, Florida State, NYU, Tulane, Baylor, UNC Chapel Hill, East Carolina and Wake Forest.
- ▶ Before entering medical school to become an orthopedic, Reynolds is teaching three different sessions of Biology 100 courses at N.C. A&T.
- ▶ He teaches two classes on Wednesday's and one class on Friday's. He has three players in his Friday class including starting left guard Macquel Hardy, wide receiver Jordan McDaniel and linebacker Chris Mosley.
- ▶ Reynolds graduated from N.C. A&T in the spring of 2018. He graduated from AggieLand is 3 1/2 years and is now seeking a degree in biomedical engineering.

N.C. A&T IS RUNNING BACK U

- ▶ North Carolina A&T has long had a tradition of producing great running backs and Marquell Cartwright is keeping the tradition going.
- ▶ Cartwright comes into the Celebration Bowl with 1,002 yards. His 1,000-yard season marks the eighth time in nine seasons the Aggies have had a 1,000-yard back.
- ▶ But the Aggies running back tradition did not start with Cartwright or even current Chicago Bear Tarik Cohen.
- ▶ The Aggies consists of 11 gentlemen who have been on NFL rosters. Eleven times in Aggies history, an Aggies tailback has had a 1,000-yard season. An amazing 12 Aggies have averaged 5.0 yards per carry or more for their respective careers (300 or more carries).
- ▶ The legacy of Aggie running backs is so rich, it even includes a College Baseball Hall of Famer in Al Holland.
- ▶ The modern-day Running Back U is believed to have started with James Fisher and Bob "Stonewall" Jackson in the late 40's and early 50's. Jackson and Fisher led the Aggies to the 1950 Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association title in 1950.
- ▶ Fisher averaged 5.6 yards per carry and scored seven touchdowns. Jackson, a fullback, was drafted by the New York Giants in 1950.
- ▶ If Fisher and Jackson were the beginning, however, J.D. Smith, Jr., was the first legend. After compiling more than 1,500 rushing yards and 21 touchdowns as an Aggie, Smith was drafted by the Chicago Bears in 1955.
- ▶ Smith is more known as a San Francisco 49er where he was a two-time Pro Bowler and ranks sixth all-time in rushing for the franchise.
- ▶ George Ragsdale, who is a former Washington Redskin and a Tampa Bay Buc, took over the RB duties in the 70's along with Holland.

RUNNING BACK U CONTINUED

- ▶ In the 80's and 90's Bill Hayes introduced the Wing-T to Aggies football and it produced the Aggies first 1,000-yard rusher in James White.
- ▶ It also produced 1,000-yard backs Milton Shaw, Maurice Smith and Maurice Hicks.
- ▶ In fact Hicks rushed for 2,812 yards in only 20 games played including a 437-yard game against Morgan State in 2000. Smith would go on to build a career with the Atlanta Falcons, while Hicks went on to be a successful running back for the 49ers.
- ▶ Then of course Tarik Cohen stepped on the scene and broke the MEAC rushing record at 5,619 yards as he put together four straight 1,000-yard seasons.
- ▶ Tarik Cohen has gone on to be successful as a running back, receiver and punt returner for the Bears.

BELL PERSEVERES TO HAVE GREAT SEASON

- ▶ Elijah Bell came into the 2018 season with large expectations after his first two seasons were historic in the history of Aggies football.
- ▶ Bell was the 2016 MEAC Rookie of the Year as well as an All-MEAC selection with a freshman record 631 receiving yards and eight touchdowns.
- ▶ His 953 yards receiving as a sophomore was the second-best single season performance in school history. He was 47 yards shy of becoming only the second player in school history to earn a 1,000-yard receiving season. His 64 catches was the second-best single-season performance in A&T history.
- ▶ But the 2018 season did not get off to a good start for Bell after a damaged foot during training camp slowed him down to open the season.
- ▶ He then considered leaving school to take care of personal issues. He credits his teammates for loving on him enough to convince him to stay at A&T.
- ▶ He went on to close the season with two 100-yard receiving games. He is two TD receptions shy of breaking the school record. He is 241 yards shy of being the Aggies all-time leading receiver.

RAYNARD'S AMAZING JOURNEY TO THE TOP OF THE PASSING LIST

- ▶ Lamar Raynard will go down as one of the best quarterbacks in school history. He has captured many of the records held by all-time great Alan Hooker for three decades.
 - ▶ But where as Hooker was a four-year starter without incident, Raynard has had some ups and downs on his way to capturing school records.
 - ▶ In 2014, he was redshirted while the Aggies went on to win the MEAC in a five-way tie that left the Aggies out of the playoffs.
 - ▶ In 2015, Raynard started the Aggies season opener but struggled at times as he shared playing time with Kwashawn Quick and Kylil Carter.
 - ▶ In fact, Rayard did not take a snap in the 2015 Celebration Bowl.
 - ▶ The next season, Raynard was the clear starter after the Aggies Week 3 loss at Tulsa. Raynard led the Aggies to five straight wins before a chest injury prior to their Nov. 12 Delaware State game ended his season forcing the Aggies to start a third-string quarterback the last three games after Carter was hurt earlier in the season.
 - ▶ Raynard returned healthy in 2017 to lead the Aggies to a 12-0 season, a MEAC title, a Celebration Bowl win and a HBCU national title. He was also named MEAC Offensive Player of the Year.
 - ▶ This season he ran into more adversity after having to play with kidney stones a groin injury and sustaining a concussion on Nov. 3 against Norfolk State.
 - ▶ The concussion forced Raynard to miss the Nov. 10 game at Savannah State. He still managed to lead the Aggies to another MEAC title, a Celebration Bowl and another chance at an HBCU national title.
- A&T WILL MISS KYLIL CARTER**
- ▶ Kylil Carter was in a bad accident back home in Georgia over the Thanksgiving break. His injuries will force him to miss the Celebration Bowl, a game he played in during the 2015 season against Alcorn.
 - ▶ Carter, a redshirt junior, has been a backup his entire career, but has had some great moments in an Aggies uniform.
 - ▶ As a freshman in 2015, he surprisingly came off the bench to lead

- ▶ the Aggies to a fourth-quarter game-winning drive to beat S.C. State 9-6 to keep the Aggies Celebration Bowl hopes alive.
- ▶ In 2016, he came in relief of a struggling Lamar Raynard and helped the Aggies upset Kent State before leaving the game with a season-ending ACL tear.
- ▶ He played in spot duty and in blowouts in 2017 before reemerging in 2018 to lead the Aggies to their upset win over East Carolina on Sept. 1. He took over for an injured Raynard and threw for 93 yards and two TDs on 7-for-9 passing.
- ▶ He also came in relief of an injured Raynard at Bethune-Cookman on Oct. 20 and threw a touchdown pass. He made his first career start at Savannah State on Nov. 10 and rushed for 93 yards and a touchdown. He was 4-for-4 passing against NCCU on Nov. 17.

WHERE'S MY DJ?

- ▶ North Carolina A&T redshirt junior defensive end Darryl Johnson, Jr., has had a marvelous season that culminated with him earning MEAC defensive player of the Year on Dec. 4 at the National Football Foundation banquet in New York City.
- ▶ Johnson became the first Aggie to win the award since Chris McNeil did it in 1997. He is the eighth different player to win the award for the Aggies program. He led the MEAC in sacks (10.5) and tackles for loss (18.5) while ranking 10th in the nation in both categories. He also made 47 tackles (29 unassisted).
- ▶ Johnson was also up for STATS FCS Defensive Player of the Year (the Buck Buchanan Award), where he finished 11th in the voting.
- ▶ Johnson is also a finalist for the Deacon Jones Trophy presented by the Black College Football Hall of Fame to the best black college football player in the country.

THE AGGIES DOMINANT DEFENSE

- ▶ A&T does not have a player with an enormous amount of tackles or a player with big interception numbers, but what they do have is one of the most consistent defenses the nation has seen over the past eight years.
- ▶ The Aggies are once again one of the best defenses in the nation. For the previous six years, their defense was ran by Sam Washington. This season Washington became the Aggies head coach leading the way for Courtney Coard to become the co-defensive coordinator.
- ▶ The tradition has continued under Coard. The Aggies have led the MEAC in total defense the past four seasons.
- ▶ A&T has led the MEAC in rush defense in seven out of the last eight seasons. The Aggies have had the best scoring defense in the league three straight years. Nationally, the Aggies have finished outside the top-10 in total defense only twice in the past eight years.

MISSING MAC MCCAIN

- ▶ The name Franklin McCain holds a lot of lore at N.C. A&T. Franklin McCain and three other N.C. A&T students staged a sit-in at the Woolworth's lunch counter in Greensboro on Feb. 1, 1960 to protest the store's policy of refusing to serve black customers.
- ▶ The foursome went on to be known as the Greensboro Four and are credited with ushering in the modern-day civil rights movement.
- ▶ McCain, who died in 2013, has a monument created in his honor along with the other Greensboro Four in Ezell Blair (now Jibreel Khazan), Joseph McNeil and David Richmond.
- ▶ McCain's grandson sophomore Franklin McCain III, was the starting corner for A&T until a torn ACL injury sustained on Oct. 20 at Bethune-Cookman ended McCain's season.
- ▶ Despite missing the Aggies final three games, the talented McCain was still named first-team All-MEAC for the second straight season.
- ▶ As a freshman, McCain III was also named a third-team AP All-American and a Phil Steele FCS Freshman All-American.
- ▶ McCain has four career pick-6's in his career including one apiece against FBS opponents — Charlotte and ECU.
- ▶ He has eight career interceptions for 374 return yards. McCain also has 24 career pass deflections.

THE TIMELY MALIK WILSON

- ▶ A&T kick returner Malik Wilson has developed good timing when returning kicks for touchdowns. Wilson should get some All-American nods for this season, which has been vital to the Aggies returning to postseason.
- ▶ Wilson's first kick return of the season came against Jacksonville State. After JSU took its first lead of the game, Wilson returned the ensuing kickoff 98 yards to give the Aggies the lead back in the third quarter.
- ▶ He opened the FAMU game with a 100-yard kickoff. After Norfolk State cut the Aggies lead to 21-20 on Nov. 3, Wilson put the game away with a 99-yard kickoff return. He is averaging 35.4 yards per return.

AGGIES IN THE PROS

- ▶ N.C. A&T has good representation in the NFL considering it is an FCS school.
- ▶ Tarik Cohen and Brandon Parker are the most noticeable because they were drafted over the past two years, but the Aggies have also seen a few players picked up in free agency.
- ▶ Two-time All-MEAC performer Tony McRae is a third-year player in the NFL. He is in the Cincinnati Bengals camp but he has played for the Bills and the Ravens as well.
- ▶ McRae made the Bengals practice squad back in 2016 to start his NFL career. He entered the NFL with Oakland as a college free agent following 2016 draft.

FROM ONE START TO LINEMAN OF THE YEAR

- ▶ Micah Shaw made his first career start at left guard during the 2015 Celebration Bowl.
- ▶ He went the next two seasons and 24 games without making a start until he got the start against Jacksonville State to open the 2018 season.
- ▶ He graded out at a season-low 71 percent with only 36 snaps played in the Aggies upset win over the Gamecocks.
- ▶ After missing the following games at East Carolina and against Gardner-Webb games with an injury. Shaw would excel from there.
- ▶ Shaw graded out at 84 percent for the season, missed only three assignments, was flagged for only three penalties and recorded 29 knockdowns in 396 snaps played.
- ▶ He went on to win MEAC offensive lineman of the week twice while also earning MEAC offensive lineman of the year to mark the fourth straight year an Aggie has won the award following Brandon Parker winning the award three straight seasons (2015-17).
- ▶ Shaw helped the Aggies have the No. 3 offense and No. 3 rush offense in the conference.
- ▶ The Aggies also had the third-best first down offense and the second-best third-down offense in the conference.
- ▶ Shaw gave up only one sack all season. What made the difference for Shaw was his play during the Aggies four-game winning streak to close the regular season.
- ▶ Shaw graded out at 90 percent or above in three of those games with the only exception being the Oct. 20 game at Bethune-Cookman where he graded out at 89 percent.

AGGIE TRANSFERS THRIVE

- ▶ N.C. A&T used a number of transfers last season to finish 12-0 with a MEAC title, a Celebration Bowl win and an HBCU national championship.
- ▶ Graduate transfers Jaquil Capel (Appalachian State) and Trey Scott (Tulane) were major players on offense. Scott even earned first-team All-MEAC honors as a tight end.
- ▶ This season has been no different for the Aggies. Certainly, Division I transfers have made a huge difference.
- ▶ Defensively, the Aggies started strong side linebacker Antoine Wilder from the University of South Carolina. Wilder is a second-team All-MEAC performer. Wilder leads the Aggies in tackles with 62.
- ▶ Aggies senior defensive end Sam Blue transferred to the Aggies from Rutgers in 2016 and became a starter this season where he made 11 tackles for loss and two sacks.
- ▶ Florida Atlantic transfer Richie Kittles is the Aggies starting free safety with 31 tackles and three pass deflections.
- ▶ Offensively, the Aggies have used Jah-Maine Martin to effectively give Marquell Cartwright a rest at running back. He was a third-team All-MEAC selection with 625 yards and seven touchdowns. He averaged 7.1 yards per carry.
- ▶ Graduate transfer Breontae Matthews has been an effective offensive lineman out of Kansas State this season with 596 snaps played.



NORTH CAROLINA A&T IS THE SCHOOL OF CHAMPIONS

- ▶ Football is not the only successful program on A&T's campus.
- ▶ During the 2017-18 school year the Aggies claimed a large amount of MEAC regular-season titles including football, women's basketball, bowling and baseball.
- ▶ The Aggies also collected MEAC tournament titles in women's basketball, bowling and baseball.
- ▶ The Aggies also captured the men's and women's 2018 MEAC indoor track and field titles before the men also captured the 2018 MEAC outdoor title while the women finished second.
- ▶ In fact, the Aggies men's indoor track team has captured the last two titles while the women have done the same. The men have also won the last two MEAC outdoor titles.
- ▶ The Aggies football team also won the HBCU national championship while women's basketball, bowling and baseball earned NCAA tournament bids with bowling earning a No. 6 seed out of 10 teams.
- ▶ The Aggies are already off to a good start this year with the football team capturing their fourth MEAC title in five years. The Aggies men's cross country team won its first MEAC title in 35 years when they claimed the title back in October.
- ▶ A&T's volleyball team reached the MEAC title match for the first time in 13 years before losing to Howard in Washington, D.C.

A GREAT FIRST YEAR FOR NEW HEAD COACH

- ▶ Sam Washington has had an impressive first year as the Aggies head coach.
- ▶ Washington heads into the 2018 Celebration Bowl with nine wins in his first season.
- ▶ If the Aggies are able to defeat Alcorn State, it would give Washington 10 wins in his first season and tie him with George Small for the most wins by a first-year Aggies head coach.
- ▶ Small went 10-3 in 2003 as he led the Aggies to the MEAC title and a playoff appearance.
- ▶ Washington led the Aggies to the 2018 MEAC crown joining Small as the only first-year Aggie coaches to ever win conference titles and reach the postseason.
- ▶ Washington did something no other first-year Aggie head coach has ever done. He opened his career with a win over a nationally-ranked program as the Aggies defeated No. 6 Jacksonville State.
- ▶ Washington followed that historic win with a victory over Division I-FBS school East Carolina becoming the first, first-year Aggies head coach to beat an FBS school.
- ▶ Washington, the MEAC coach of the year, led the Aggies to a 3-0 and the No. 4 ranking in the country after their win over Gardner-Webb.
- ▶ The Aggies were then upset by Morgan State and later Florida A&M before Washington led the team to four straight wins to close the season.

N.C. A&T HEAD FOOTBALL COACH SAM WASHINGTON



Sam Washington became the 19th head football coach in North Carolina A&T State history on January 9, 2018. Washington has often said he inherited a Ferrari from previous coach Rod Broadway. Washington did nothing to wreck it in his first season.

The Aggies are 9-2 heading into the 2018 Air Force Reserve Celebration Bowl. Washington opened his head coaching career with a win over the No. 6 team in the Football Championship Subdivision, Jacksonville State. A week later the Washington-led Aggies defeated East Carolina from the highly-regarded Football Bowl Subdivision. The only two games Washington lost in his first season came on last-second field goals. The Aggies ended the regular season with four straight wins to win the outright Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference title. One of those wins came against archrival N.C. Central where the Aggies won 45-0 and had more points than the Eagles had total yards.

By winning the MEAC, Washington became the third person to win a conference football title in his first year as the Aggies head coach joining Hornsby Howell (1968) and George Small (2003). After the regular-season, he was named MEAC Coach of the Year. He is the second Aggie head coach in school history to win the award in his first season.

Prior to being promoted to head coach, Washington served as the Aggies defensive coordinator and secondary coach for seven years. In 2015, he was

promoted to associate head coach. He has established himself as one of the best defensive minds in Division I-FCS. The Aggies improvement defensively under Washington is remarkable. Under Washington, the Aggies have finished out the top-20 in total defense only once nationally, and they have never finished outside the top-30. In two of those seasons, they were second nationally in total defense. The run defense has finished outside the top-10 nationally once, and in 2013 the Aggies led the nation in run defense.

A year before his arrival in 2011, A&T was ranked 89th in total defense, 114th in rushing defense and 78th in pass defense nationally. In three of Washington's seven seasons, the Aggies have finished among the top-10 teams in passing defense efficiency including No. 1 in 2012. The Aggies have been the MEAC's No. 1 total defense and scoring defense four times in

the past seven years. They have had the No. 1 total defense in the conference three straight seasons. N.C. A&T has also had the No. 1 rush defense in the conference six times in seven years.

In 2017, the defense was instrumental in the Aggies finishing the season 12-0 with the MEAC title, the Celebration Bowl victory and the HBCU national title. Washington's defense finished fourth nationally, third in the nation in scoring defense and fifth in the nation in run defense. In his role as the secondary coach, five different cornerbacks have earned All-MEAC success in D'Vonte Graham, Justin Ferrell, Tony McRae, Donald Mattocks and Marquis Boyan with only Boyan not earning first-team honors. Graham, McRae and Mattocks have all earned All-American honors from various organizations. Two of Washington's corners – McRae and Ayojeji Olatoye – signed free agent contracts with NFL teams with Olatoye making the Dallas Cowboys 53-man roster in 2015 and playing the Super Bowl in 2017.

In 2017 and '18, the Aggies had two cornerbacks – Mac McCain and Timadre Abram – earn first-team All-MEAC honors with McCain going on to win All-American honors by *Phil Steele Magazine* and the *Associated Press* (third team). Marquis Ragland earned three first-team All-MEAC selections as a defensive lineman, linebacker D'Vonte Grant was a Jerry Rice finalist for best FCS rookie in 2011 and

linebacker Denzel Jones was the defensive MVP of the 2015 Air Force Reserve Celebration Bowl.

Before arriving at A&T, Washington spent four seasons as Grambling's defensive backs coach under Broadway. Washington played a significant role in the Tigers' dominating defense in 2007. Nationally, the Tigers ranked 12th in total defense. During the next season, Washington's defensive backfield played a vital role in Grambling being an opportunistic defense. Grambling led the nation in turnover margin and was third in scoring defense. Defensive back Desmond Lenard returned one interception for a touchdown and was ninth in the nation in interceptions per game. Three other defensive backs ranked among the Top-50 in interceptions per game that season.

Before Washington came to Grambling, he spent five years at his alma mater Mississippi Valley State. Washington served as an assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in addition to his customary role as the defensive backs coach. In his first season at MVSU, he transformed the Delta Devils defense from one of the worst defenses in the SWAC into the league's No. 2 ranked defense.

Before returning to MVSU, Washington spent one season (2001) as A&T's special teams coordinator under then head coach Bill Hayes. Under Washington, the Aggies had one of the best special teams seasons in school history. The Aggies led the nation in punt return yardage per game

with punt returner Curtis Deloatch breaking the NCAA's single-season record for punt return touchdowns. Punter Yonnick Matthews was second in the MEAC in punting.

Washington also spent eight seasons at N.C. Central as the school's assistant head coach and defensive coordinator. Led by All-American Buddy Crutchfield, Adrian Jones and Trei Oliver in 1996, Washington put together one of the best defensive backfields in Division II as the Eagles went 8-3 with the best pass defense in the CIAA. In 1992, he began work at Johnson C. Smith. He was named the assistant head coach. His other duties included being the defensive and special teams coordinator, the defensive backs coach and the head track and field coach.

Washington's coaching profession also includes a stint with Bethune-Cookman (1987-92), where he helped the Wildcats take a share of the 1988 MEAC championship. In 1998, he secured an internship with the NFL's Tampa Bay Buccaneers under legendary head coach Tony Dungy. Washington is no stranger to the NFL. He spent four seasons in the NFL with stops in Pittsburgh and Cincinnati. As a member of the Pittsburgh Steelers, Washington intercepted at least one pass in five consecutive games during the 1984 season.

Washington earned a B.S., degree in physical education from MVSU in 1982. He was inducted into the MVSU Hall of Fame in 2006. He and his wife Donna have one son, Jarvis.
