### QUICKIE NOTES

- ▶ North Carolina A&T is off to its best start in 30 years, and they are having the best November in school history.
- ▶ The Aggies started playing five or more games in November during the 1998-99 season. The most wins the Aggies have had in the month November since that point prior to this season was four in 2007, '08, '10 and '11. The Aggies already have five November wins with one November game remaining.
- ▶ The most wins they have had over a Division I school in November is three during the 2007-08 season. The Aggies have defeated Division I foes The Citadel, Jacksonville and East Carolina this month and hope to set the new mark against Central Connecticut State.
- ▶ North Carolina A&T has had a resurgence in winning non-conference games on the road. The Aggies went four straight seasons (2013-17) without winning a non-conference road game, compiling a 0-36 record over that time frame.
- ▶ This season A&T has already secured two non-conference road wins with six more to play. The Aggies are 5-63 on the road over the previous four seasons.

- ▶ Aaren Edmead missed the Aggies first four games of the season. He is making up for lost time. He has scored a combined 38 points in his first two games as an Aggie including a 25-point night at ECU. Femi Olujobi scored 23 in the game, marking the first time since March 3, 2016, two Aggies have scored 20 or more in the same game.
- ▶ Olujobi continues to lead the nation in scoring (28.3). He is second in total field goals made (60), fourth in total points (170), sixth in free throw attempts (59), seventh in free throws made (45). Olujobi's rebounding has not been too shabby either. He is 18th in the nation in defensive rebounding (7.83) and 26th in rebounding (10.2).
- ▶ N.C. A&T scored more than 80 points three times last season. The Aggies have exceeded 80 points in all but one game this season and they came against Clemson of the ACC. The Aggies lead the MEAC in scoring (91.8) and rank 13th nationally.
- ▶ CCU and N.C. A&T have common opponents this season. CCU also defeated ECU as they traveled to Greenville and came away with an 11-point win. CCU also defeated Coppin State of the MEAC. The Aggies play the Eagles on Jan. 15.

## ABOUT AGGIES BASKETBALL IN 2017-18

- ▶ North Carolina A&T went 3-29 last season, therefore, they have already exceeded their win total from last season.
- ▶ In addition, the Aggies only defeated one Division I team a year ago. They have already defeated three in The Citadel, Jacksonville and East Carolina.
- ▶ The Aggies lead the MEAC in several statistical categories including assist-to-turnover ratio (1.37), assists per game (19.0), defensive rebounds per game (30.2), fewest fouls (1110, field goal percentage (.505), scoring margin (+12.0), scoring offense (91.8) and total assists (114).
- ▶ Nationally they rank in the top-40 in assists per game (17th), defensive rebounds per game (27th), scoring offense (11th) and free throws made (39th, 123).
- ▶ The Aggies ended a 36-game losing streak on the road to non-conference opponents earlier this season when they went to Jacksonville and defeated the Jacksonville Dolphins in overtime.
- ▶ Prior to beating Jacksonville on the road, the Aggies' previous road win over a non-conference opponent came on Dec. 28, 2013 at Georgia Southern.

## IF THE AGGIES WIN...

- ▶ They will continue the best November in school history by improving to 6-1. If the Aggies are able to win it will be hard to overcome the mark considering the number of money games the Aggies play in November.
- ▶ It will be their first-ever win over Central Connecticut State. It will also be their first win over a team from Connecticut and a team from the Northeast Conference.
- ▶ It will give guard Aaren Edmead and forward Japhet Kadji their fourth career win over Central Connecticut. Before transferring to N.C. A&T, Edmead and Kadji played two years at NEC school Wagner. Edmead and Kadji helped Wagner take three of four from the Blue Devils at Wagner.
- ▶ It will give the Aggies their fifth straight victory. It will be the Aggies longest winning streak since winning five in a row toward the end of the 2013 season.
- ▶ They will continue to be the only one-loss team in the MEAC.

## OLUJOBI MAKES HIS WAY TO GREENSBORO

- ▶ Femi Olujobi has taken Aggie nation by storm by scoring 147 points in his first five games as an Aggie. It is the most points an Aggie has scored over the first five games in school history.
- ▶ Olujobi's journey to N.C. A&T was an unlikely one.
- ▶ Olujobi attended Brentwood High School in Long Island where he led Brentwood to the Long Island championship as a senior.
- ▶ But it was in his senior season when he injured his leg, leading numerous Division I schools to stop calling. When Oakland University offered Olujobi he took, thinking his injury were preventing others from giving him a scholarship offer.
- ▶ Olujobi scored nine points in his first game as a Golden Grizzly, but slowly saw his playing time dwindled to the point where he made eight starts as a freshman and one start as a sophomore.
- ▶ Olujobi decided to leave Oakland U after sophomore year and said he at first would avoid head coach Jay Joyner's calls from N.C. A&T. But once he got on campus and saw the Aggies offense and the family atmosphere, he decided to sign.

## WHERE ARE THEY NOW?

- ▶ North Carolina A&T's roster underwent some major changes. There were even players with eligibility who parted ways with the Aggies.
- ▶ Greensboro native Sam Hunt is now at North Carolina State playing as a graduate transfer after graduating from N.C. A&T in 2017. Hunt led the Aggies in scoring last season.
- ▶ Eliel Gonzalez, who averaged 10.1 points last season, signed a professional contract in Puerto Rico and gave up his senior year of eligibility.
- ▶ James Whitaker and Nick Reese graduated and decided not to return for their final season of eligibility. Joshua Mullins also decided not to return after one season with the Aggies.

## A&T BY THE NUMBERS...

- 6** — It is the number of seasons since the Aggies last had a first-team All-MEAC performer. Thomas Coleman earned first-team honors during the 2010-11 season.
- 7** — It is the number of career 1,000-point scorers the Aggies have secured since the 2008-09 season. Players include Steven Rush, Adrian Powell, Thomas Coleman, Bruce Beckford, Nic Simpson and Lamont Middleton.
- 30** — It is the number of seasons since the Aggies have had someone named MEAC Player of the Year. In the 1980's, an Aggies player was named player of the year six times. But Claude Williams was the last Aggie to accomplish the feat during the 1987-88 season.

- 532** — It is the number of points Denzel Keyes has scored as a football player and a basketball player at N.C. A&T. Keyes, a wide receiver for the Aggies from 2013-16, caught a school-record 25 career touchdown passes for 150 points. As a basketball player, he has scored 373 points as he finishes out his fourth season in the program.

## AGGIES TRANSFORM ROSTER

▶ N.C. A&T head coach Jay Joyner transformed the Aggies roster during the offseason.

▶ Joyner always knew he had talent sitting out even throughout the Aggies rough three-win season in 2016-17. Two of those players sitting out were Wagner Division I transfers in Aaren Edmead and Japhet Kadji.

▶ Edmead, who is slated as the Aggies backup point guard, played his first game for the Aggies on Nov. 21 against Mid-Atlantic Christian where he scored 13 points and four assists. Kadji has started four games for the Aggies and had his first game in double figures on Nov. 21 with 15 points.

▶ Olujobi, a transfer from Oakland University, has become the best scorer in the nation thus far.

▶ Joyner then brought in two junior college transfers in scorers Kwei Lartey and Milik Gantz. Lartey is a starter for the Aggies averaging more than 25 minutes per game, while Gantz is a backup combo guard.

▶ There was a graduate transfer added to the mix out of Georgia Southern in Devonte Boykins. Boykins is the second-leading scorer for the Aggies.

▶ Three true freshmen were also added in D'Andre Johnson, Kameron Langley and Myles Patten. Johnson is slowly developing, while Langley has stepped in and become the Aggies starting point guard.

## RETURNING PLAYERS

▶ N.C. A&T did return five players from the 2016-17 season in Donte Watson, Davaris McGowens, Raymon Pratt, Amari Hamilton and Austin Williams.

▶ Watson, McGowens, Pratt and Hamilton started numerous games for the Aggies, while Williams served as a backup point guard.

▶ Watson started eight of the 20 games he played and averaged 6.8 points. McGowens led the Aggies in rebounding (6.9) after starting 24 times in 31 games. Pratt started 14 games, while Hamilton became an effective 3-point shooter (.352).

## AGGIES GET THEIR KEYES BACK

- ▶ For three years, Denzel Keyes served as the Aggies top wide receiver in football on a championship team and as its rebounding forward on the men's basketball team.
- ▶ In 2015-16, Keyes led the football team in receiving before leading the men's basketball team in rebounds per game (7.3).
- ▶ Keyes played football in 2016, helping the Aggies to a 9-3 mark and an appearance in the NCAA FCS playoffs. Even though he had one year of eligibility remaining in basketball, he turned his focus to an attempt at a professional football career, therefore, he skipped playing basketball.
- ▶ As a football player, Keyes ended his career as the Aggies all-time leader in career touchdown receptions with 25. He was a two-time All-MEAC second-team selection who once owned the school's single-season touchdown receptions record (10) that was broken in 2017.
- ▶ Keyes' football dreams have not yet come true, so at the asking of head coach Jay Joyner, Keyes decided to return to the court to take his final year of basketball eligibility. In all, Keyes has played in 119 athletic contests for the N.C. A&T Department of Athletics over the past five years.
- ▶ As a basketball player, Keyes has scored 382 points and grabbed 308 rebounds, while shooting 43.8 percent from the floor and he has shot 51.8 percent from 2-point range.
- ▶ As a football player, Keyes made 111 receptions for 1,333 yards and 25 touchdowns. He played 44 games as a N.C. A&T football player from 2013-16.

## JOYNER SPORTS A BRAND NEW LOOK

- ▶ After coming off a tough season, N.C. A&T head coach Jay Joyner decided to make some changes.
- ▶ He not only made changes to the men's basketball team, bringing in nine new players along with two new coaches, but he also transformed his body.
- ▶ During the offseason, Joyner changed his diet and lost more than 30 pounds to give himself more energy in practice and on the sideline when coaching games.
- ▶ Joyner is now back close to his playing weight when he was a standout forward at S.C. State in the mid-90's as a 6-foot-7, 220-pound forward.

## JOYNER HIRES HIS HIGH SCHOOL COACH

- ▶ Jack Agostino, who sustained major success for more than 25 years at a New York high school, will serve as the new Aggies associate head coach starting in the 2017-18 season.
- ▶ Agostino won 473 games over the 27 years he served as head coach of Amityville High School, a public school on the south shore of Long Island, N.Y. Agostino served as Joyner's high school coach from 1990-92.
- ▶ Agostino posted a .787 winning percentage as the Warriors head man and ranks fifth in Long Island history in prep wins. He won four straight state Class A public school and state Federation titles (2000-03), becoming the only Long Island boys basketball team to accomplish the feat. Amityville won 23 league, 11 county class titles and nine Long Island titles under Agostino.
- ▶ As the associated head coach at N.C. A&T, he will serve as Joyner's offensive and defensive coordinator.

## JOYNER ADDS ANOTHER COACH TO THE MIX

- ▶ In addition to adding his former high school coach Jack Agostino, Joyner also added another assistant coach in David Butts.
- ▶ Butts has spent time on the prep, junior college and collegiate level. Butts comes to N.C. A&T after spending one season at Division III Rosemont College.
- ▶ During the 2016-17 season, Rosemont went 16-11 overall and 13-5 in the Colonial States Athletic Conference. The Philadelphia native also spent one season (2015-16) at Rise Academy Prep in Philadelphia.
- ▶ Butts had a three-year stint (2012-15) at Cecil College, a junior in North East, Md. In addition to being responsible for the skill development of the Aggies post players and in-game management, Butts will also handle team travel, assists in recruiting and monitor academics.
- ▶ Will Jones and Ray Martin will remain on the staff from last season. Will Jones will remain on the staff for his second season to serve as the Aggies recruiting coordinator and guard/wings coach. Ray Martin, who was recently inducted into the Old-Timers of America Hall of Fame in New York City, will serve as the director of basketball operations in his second season with the program.

## LOCAL FRESHMAN POINT GUARD MAKES EARLY IMPACT

- ▶ Freshman Kameron Langley comes from a basketball family, and he is only adding to the basketball reputation of the Langley family.
- ▶ In five short games, Langley's play as the Aggies starting point guard is the reason why the team is off to a fast start.
- ▶ Langley has scored 45 points, dished out 29 assists and has been credited with only 11 turnovers. He is shooting 58.6 percent (17-for-29) from the floor while averaging 27.5 minutes per game.
- ▶ Langley leads the MEAC in assists-to-turnover ratio (2.64). He is fourth in the league in assists per game (4.8), sixth in total assists (29) and he is second in steals per game (2.0).
- ▶ Langley's younger twin brothers, who are attending Southwest Guilford like he did, have already committed to Virginia Tech.
- ▶ His older brother Keyford Langley plays for Greensboro College. The two brothers played against one another this season during the Aggies season opener on Nov. 10.

## THE AGGIES NEW YORK CONNECTIONS

- ▶ During the late 1970's and throughout the 80's, much of the Aggies success in the MEAC was due to New Yorker's such as Joe Binion, James Sparrow and Claude Williams.
- ▶ There seems to be a resurgence of New Yorkers at N.C. A&T again. It starts with head coach Jay Joyner who is from Long Island, NY and came to N.C. A&T through former Aggies head coach Cy Alexander who hired Joyner as his associate head coach in 2012. Joyner played for Alexander at S.C. State (1993-96).
- ▶ Joyner brought in Jack Agostino and Ray Martin to be on his staff. Agostino was a longtime high school coach in Long Island while Martin was born and raised in Long Island City, NY.
- ▶ From the players standpoint there is another Long Island connection in Femi Olujobi who attended Brentwood High School and led Brentwood to a Long Island championship.
- ▶ Point guard Austin Williams is not from Long Island, but he comes from Queens, NY where he was a showstopper at Believe Prep Academy.
- ▶ Two more Aggies come from New York in point guard Aaren Edmead who comes from Deer Park and Myles Patten who hails from Brooklyn.

### HEAD COACH JAY JOYNER

Jay Joyner was announced as the head men's basketball coach at North Carolina A&T hours before the Aggies faced Coppin State in a MEAC Basketball Championship Tournament game on March 7, 2016. Joyner was named interim head coach weeks earlier on Jan. 29, 2016 after the resignation of Cy Alexander.

Under Joyner, the Aggies closed out the 2015-16 regular season with a 5-4 record overall and a 5-3 mark in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference. Before becoming N.C. A&T's head coach, Joyner furthered his longtime relationship with Alexander as he served as the Aggies associate head coach (2012-16) under Alexander. Previously Joyner had played for Alexander as a student-athlete at S.C. State. He also worked with Alexander as an assistant prior to N.C. A&T. Alexander even served on Joyner's staff at Columbia State Community College.

As the Aggies associate head coach, Joyner took the lead in the Aggies recruiting efforts. In his first season with the Aggies program, the Aggies won the MEAC title, won its first-ever NCAA tournament game and won 20 games for the first time in 25 years. Before coming to Greensboro, Joyner spent three seasons as the head men's basketball coach at Columbia State Community College, a two-year school in Middle Tennessee. Joyner led the Chargers to a 61-23 record and two Tennessee Community College Athletic Association regular-season titles.

In 2012, the Charges made their first national tournament appearance in 34 years. The 2011-12 team went 23-8 and finished the season ranked sixth in the nation. Joyner earned the 2011-12 National Junior College Athletic Association District 7 Coach of the Year honor and was named the TCCAA Coach of the Year in 2010 and '12.

Joyner spent the 2008-2009 season as an assistant coach for the Cumberland University men's basketball program, a National As-

sociation Intercollegiate Athletics institution, in Lebanon, Tenn. He helped the Bulldogs to an NAIA National Championship Tournament appearance with a 26-6 record. He developed the post players, coordinated all recruiting, and scouted each opponent. He was also responsible for implementing the team's game plan.

Prior to finding success in Tennessee, Joyner gained experience working in the Big East. Joyner served as the director of player development for Rutgers University (2006-08), and spent two seasons developing and managing the Scarlet Knights' mentoring program. He worked with each student-athlete to help enhance their athletic performance through video sessions. He also handled NCAA compliance documentation for student-athletes and assisted with scheduling. Joyner also served as the campus liaison for recruits.

His coaching career began in Tennessee, where he served as the assistant coach at Columbia State Community College for the 2005-06 season, helping guide the Chargers to the conference championship game under head coach Malcolm Montgomery.

Joyner got his professional start in athletics in 2003, where he served as the administrative assistant/assistant strength coach for the men's basketball program at Tennessee State under Alexander. In his two years at TSU, he monitored the academic progress for Alexander's players and ran the program's strength and conditioning workouts. He was responsible for the daily operations in the men's basketball office and coordinated film exchange with other institutions. He was the co-director of the Cy Alexander Basketball Camp as well.

Before making the jump to collegiate athletics, Joyner was an assistant boys basketball coach at Centennial High School in Franklin, Tenn., for the 2002-03 season.

Joyner's familiarity with the Aggies comes from his playing career with S.C. State from 1993-96. He was part of the Bulldogs' 1995-96 championship team under Alexander. After leaving S.C. State, he competed professionally overseas.

Joyner holds a bachelor's degree in physical education from Middle Tennessee State. He is a native of Amityville, N.Y. He and his wife have three children.

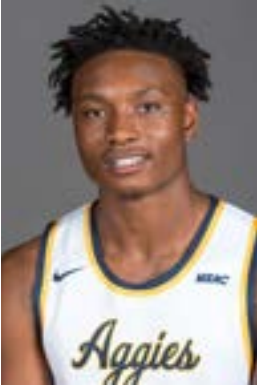
