LEADING IT OFF

- The Terps play host to Boston College at Bob "Turtle" Smith Stadium in their final regular-season series of the season. The three-game set gets underway Thursday at 6:30 p.m. with **Jimmy Reed** taking on Hunter Gordon.
- Maryland is 3-3 in its last six ACC contests. The Terps took two of three from Duke in Durham three weekends ago and won the opener against 17th-ranked Clemson, 7-2, on May 4 behind eight strong innings from Reed.
- The Terps begin the weekend ranked 26th in the RPI and have wins over six teams currently ranked in the top 25 in the RPI including three wins over teams in the top 10 (No. 3 Virginia, No. 5 Florida State and No. 7 NC State).
- In their last six ACC games, the Terps are hitting .278 with 15 extra base hits. While the pitching staff is sporting a 4.24 ERA and holding opponents to a .254 batting average. Individually, **Charlie White** is hitting .480 in the six games with a .536 OBP to lead the club. **Jordan Hagel** is slugging a team-best .520 with two doubles and a home run, and leads the team with five RBI.

- Maryland has faced a daunting schedule this season, which currently ranks as the fifth-strongest schedule in the country as compiled by Warren Nolan. The Terps have faced seven teams currently ranked in the *Baseball America* Top 25 including three in the top 5 (No. 2 LSU, No. 3 North Carolina and No. 5 NC State).

TERRAPIN TRENDS

- Maryland has recorded at least one stolen base in six of its last 11 games including two multi-steal games. The Terps continue to be one of the most aggressive teams in the country on the basepaths. The Terps are third in the ACC with 93 steals, a total which is tied for 20th nationally.

- **Charlie White** leads the ACC in steals (39) and is tied for third nationally. Campbell's Ben McQuown and Wagner's Ian Miller are tied for lead nationally with 45 SBs. White is averaging 0.75 steals per game and has swiped 14 bags ACC play, which leads the conference. By stealing his 34th base of the season against Mt. St. Mary's (4/17), White became Maryland's all-time single-season stolen base leader.

- White enters the weekend one stolen bases shy of Maryland's career record. The sophomore's 61 career stolen bases is tied for 27th nationally among active players.

- **Jimmy Reed** continued to be in top form last time out at Clemson on May 4. Reed struck out a career-high 11 batters and held the Tigers to two runs over eight innings for his sixth win of the season. Reed's effort earned him ACC Pitcher of the Week honors for the second consecutive week becoming the first Maryland pitcher to win the award in back-to-back weeks since its inception in 1992.

- Reed threw his first career complete-game shutout at Duke on April 26 en route to his first ACC Pitcher of the Week award. Reed is one of five pitchers in the conference to throw at least two complete games in league action, and is one of six to toss a complete-game shutout.

- **Jake Stinnett**, Friday's projected starter, is holding opponents to a .216 batting average, the seventh-best mark in the ACC. In conference action, Stinnett ranks ninth with an opponent batting average of .239. In his last six starts, Stinnett has lowered his ERA to 3.21, which ranks 21st in the ACC.

- Since his April 3 start against Rider, Stinnett has posted a team-best 1.69 ERA and is 4-2 with a 2.7 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- With a grand slam at Towson (4/24), **LaMonte Wade** became the first Terrapin to record a grand slam since Dan Benick hit one at Virginia on April 4, 2009. It is also marked Wade's first career home run.

• **Kevin Mooney** registered his eighth save in the Terps' 4-2 win at Liberty on May 1 tying him with Brett Cecil and **Jimmy Reed** for the second-most saves in a single-season in program history. Cecil holds the record with 13 in 2006. Reed had eight saves in 2012 before moving to the weekend rotation.

• The Terps have 113 doubles, which is second in the conference to Florida State (121) and ranks eighth nationally. The Terps are averaging 2.17 per game, which is the second-best average in the ACC. The team is within striking distance of the program-record 129 doubles in 2001.

• The Terps lead the nation with 79 sacrifice bunts. Maryland has recorded a sacrifice in 41 of 52 games.

• The Terps' 11 run outburst against Towson (4/30) was the seventh time this season Maryland has scored 10-plus runs in a game. In addition, the Terps have scored 16 runs twice this year (at Geroge Mason, 4/10; vs. Towson, 4/30). Sixteen is the most runs scored by the Terps this season and the most since the team scored 21 against Duke on April 14, 2012.

• Maryland has scored five or more runs 27 times this season and are 21-6 in those contests.

• The Terrapins have out hit their opponents in 30 of their 52 games this season and are 18-12 in those contests.

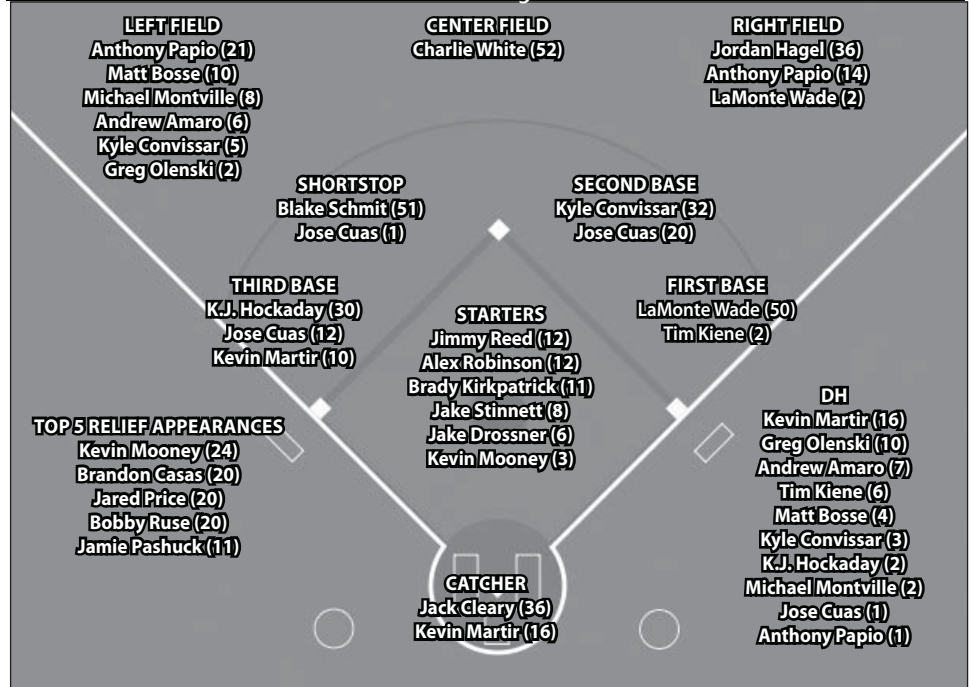

• **Kyle Convissar** has been hit by a pitch 20 times and in three of his last six games. His season total leads the ACC and is tied for ninth nationally. In his career, the junior has been hit 47 times, which is tied for the 11th-highest total among active players nationally and is the most in program history.

• Maryland is 21-2 when leading after six innings. The record improves to 24-2 when taking a lead into the eighth and is a perfect 26-0 when taking it to the ninth.

SERIES HISTORY

• Maryland trails 7-16 in the all-time series against Boston College.

• Since 2007 in nine meetings in College Park, the Terps are 3-6. In 2011, Maryland won the second game of the series 4-3, but dropped the opening game and the series finale.

• Last season in Chestnut Hill, the Terps avoided the sweep by winning the last game of the series, 7-1.

SCOUTING THE EAGLES

• After losing its first 20 ACC games, Boston College has won three of its last six conference contests including a series victory over Miami at home. Last weekend, the Eagles lost two of three to Virginia Tech.

• The Eagles rank 12th in the ACC in almost all offensive categories. BC is batting .209 on the season with a .185 batting average in conference action. On the mound, BC's pitching staff has an ERA of 5.51, which ranks 12th in the conference, and an ACC ERA of 5.02, which ranks ninth.

• Matt Pare leads the team in hitting with a .267 average and has a team-high 19 RBI and four home runs. Chris Shaw leads the team in homers (5) and has 18 RBI.

• Friday's projected starter, Hunter Gordon, ranks 13th in league action with a 3.05 ERA with opponents hitting .255 against. Gordon is averaging 5.88 strikeouts per nine. Nate Bayuk leads the team in appearances out of the pen (24) and is 0-1 with a 5.06 ERA.

WEEK IN REVIEW

• The Terps have been off the past week as the team prepared for finals. Last time out against VCU on May 8, the Rams knocked off the Terps, 9-7.

RECORD HOLDER

• With a stolen base against Mt. St. Mary's (4/17), **Charlie White** increased his season total to 34 to become Maryland's single-season stolen base leader surpassing Larry Long's mark set in 1998 (33).

• For his career, White has swiped 61 bases, which ranks third all-time. He needs one stolen bases to tie Larry Long and Alfredo Rodriguez for the most in program history.

REED MAKING A STATEMENT

• **Jimmy Reed**, who leads the team in ERA (2.35) and strikeouts (63), has solidified himself as the ace of the staff. Reed has held 10 of his 12 opponents to three earned runs or less.

• The senior lefty struck out a career-high 11 at Clemson on May 4 to earn his sixth win of the season en route to his second ACC Pitcher of the Week honor in as many weeks. Reed is the first Maryland pitcher to win the award in consecutive weeks since its inception in 1992.

• Reed pitched his first career complete game shutout at Duke (4/26) to earn ACC Pitcher of the Week honors. Reed is the first Maryland pitcher to throw a complete game shutout since Scott Swinson held Delaware scoreless on May 13, 2008.

• Against NC State (3/29), Reed held the Wolfpack to three hits over his final seven innings and topped that performance two weeks later against Miami (4/12). Reed held the Canes scoreless over nine innings while tying a career high with 10 strikeouts.

• Reed's 2.35 ERA ranks ninth in the ACC and he is one of six pitchers in the ACC to pitch two complete games in league action.

STINNETT LOOKING LIKE A STARTER

• Since his April 3 start against Rider, **Jake Stinnett** has looked every bit like a top-flight hurler. The junior is 4-2 with a 1.69 ERA in six starts holding opponents to a .205 average. On the season, Stinnett ranks seventh in the ACC with a .216 b/avg.

• Stinnett has five quality starts in his last six outings including his first career complete game at Duke (4/28).

MOONEY GETS THE CALL IN THE NINTH

• Since moving to the bullpen following a March 10 start at Virginia, **Kevin Mooney** has thrived in late game situations. The freshman is 8-for-9 in save situations and has a 1.38 K/BB ratio in relief.

• Mooney is tied for third in the ACC with eight saves, while his three ACC saves is tied for the third-highest total in the conference. Mooney is tied with Brett Cecil and **Jimmy Reed** for the second-most saves in a single-season in program history. Cecil holds the record with 13 in 2006. Reed had eight saves in 2012 before moving to the weekend rotation.

WADE PROVING TO BE VERY VERSATILE

• **LaMonte Wade** has started all 52 games this season appearing at three different positions. The freshman has made 50 starts at first base, two starts in right field, and six appearances as a pitcher in relief.

• Wade leads the team in RBI (37) and triples (3). Wade is also tied for the team-lead in doubles (14). While at first base and the outfield, Wade

has committed only two errors in 496 chances for a .996 fielding percentage. On the mound, Wade has not surrendered a run in four of his six appearances and has not issued a walk in six innings pitched.

OFF AND RUNNING

• Through the first 52 games of the season, Maryland has been one of the most aggressive base running teams in the country. The Terps are third in the ACC with 93 stolen bases, which is tied for the 20th-highest total nationally.

• The Terps stole 26 bases in four games against Oakland and set a program record with 11 in game one of Friday's doubleheader. A check of media relations contacts throughout the country did not reveal a higher weekend stolen base total nationally. The 11 stolen bases against Oakland (2/22) is the highest single-game total for an ACC team this year.

HONORED TERP

• **Charlie White** has been the focal point of Maryland's running game so far this season. White has an ACC-best 39 stolen bases. He stole four in game one of a Friday doubleheader against Oakland (2/22) becoming the first player to do that since 1998 (Larry Long vs. Howard 4/15/98).

• After swiping 10 bases in four games against Oakland (2/22-24), White won numerous honors. White became the first Terrapin positional player to earn ACC Player of the Week honors since 2002 (Seth Kane).

• White also was recognized as the NWBCA National Hitter of the Week and one of Louisville Slugger's National Players of the Week by *Collegiate Baseball Newspaper*.

SETTING THE TABLE

• A large part of Maryland's offensive success this season is attributed to the team's ability to get runners on base to start the inning and moving them along.

• The Terps are hitting .409 (188-for-460) to lead off innings with **LaMonte Wade** 21-for-43 (.488).

• Once on base, Maryland has been moving its runners well. With 100 sacrifices (79 bunts, 21 flies), Maryland leads the nation in sacrifice bunts.

NON CONFERENCE SUCCESS

• The Terps have been dominate in non-conference action recently. Maryland has won 41 of its last 51 non-conference games (.804). So far this season, the Terps have swept a four-game set against Oakland and Princeton, and won two midweek contests against JMU, Liberty, Towson and VCU, and one each against George Mason, Marist and Rider.

• Over the last two seasons, the Terps are 57-20 against non-conference foes.

TERPS DEBUT IN CBN POLL

• The Terps cracked the *Collegiate Baseball Newspaper* Top 30 poll on March 4. Maryland checked in at No. 30.

• Last season, Maryland appeared in the *Collegiate Baseball Newspaper* Top 30 poll on Feb. 27 and March 5 and climbed to No. 21.

TERRAPIN DEBUTS

• So far this season, 15 Terrapins have made their collegiate debuts.

• Twelve Terps made their Maryland debuts at LSU to open the year including 10 freshmen: **Brandon Casas, Jose Cuas, Jake Drossner, Kevin Martir, Kevin Mooney, Kyle Moore, Jared Price, Alex Robinson, LaMonte Wade and Alex Yee.**

First Season at Maryland
Drexel '89

John Szefc became the seventh head in the 120-year history of the Maryland baseball program on July 18, 2012, after serving as the associate head coach at Kansas State for the 2011 and 2012 seasons.

Szefc (pronounced CHEF) comes to Maryland with a proven track record as a recruiter and hitting coach. He has served as recruiting coordinator at his last three stops, and as head coach, led Marist College to four conference championships and three NCAA Regional appearances in a seven-year stint from 1996-2002.

In his career, he has coached in 24 NCAA Regional games, coached and developed 13 All-Americans, and accumulated a 571-382 overall record as an assistant and head coach.

Szefc, who has coached 69 players that have been drafted or signed professional contracts since 1997, brings an aggressive offensive style. He helped lead Kansas State to a NCAA Regional in 2011, when the Wildcats led the Big 12 in stolen bases with 123 while placing 10th in school history with 564 hits on the year.

Szefc came to Manhattan after a two-year stint at the University of Kansas where he was the team's hitting coach and recruiting coordinator. While in Lawrence, Szefc helped lead the Jayhawks to two Big 12 Championship appearances and a NCAA Regional berth during his first season in 2009.

With Szefc's guidance, the Jayhawks made a 17-point improvement in overall team batting average from .287 in 2008 to .304 in 2010. In Big 12 games in 2010, Kansas hit .305, which ranked second in the conference, while it led the league in base hits (304), and finished second in runs scored (195) and walks (115) during league play.

Prior to his position at Kansas, Szefc was the head assistant coach at Louisiana-Lafayette from 2003-08, running an aggressive-style Ragin' Cajun offense that saw a dramatic 60-point jump in batting average during his first three years. Three of his team's batting averages still rank in the top five of Louisiana-Lafayette history and his 2005 squad set a school record for hits and finished second in school history in runs scored and RBI. The 2002 team tied the school record with 145 stolen bases.

Szefc posted a 212-137-1 record as the skipper for Marist, leading the Red Foxes to their first baseball title as a member of the Northeast Conference in 1997. He also guided Marist to three more NCAA Tournament appearances in 2000, 2001 and 2002, including a 41-14 record during his final year at the school. The 2002 squad claimed a victory over Southwest Missouri State in the NCAA Lincoln Regional, while five of Szefc's players on that team went on to be selected in the MLB Draft.

Szefc won multiple awards as a head coach. He was named the 1997 NEC Coach of the year, while he earned American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Northeast Region Coach of the Year honors in 2001.

Before his arrival at Marist, Szefc spent one season with Sacred Heart University and four years as an assistant coach with his alma mater, Drexel, from 1990-94.

Szefc managed the New York Generals in the Atlantic College Baseball League (ACBL) during the summers of 1995 and 1996, guiding the club to a 47-28 record in two seasons, two consecutive Kaiser Division championships and the ACBL championship game in 1996.

Szefc, a native of Middletown, N.Y., played collegiately for two years at Connecticut before transferring in 1987 to Drexel. During his senior campaign for the Dragons, he was tabbed an All-East Coast Conference outfielder.

Szefc graduated from Drexel University with a degree in corporate communications in 1989. He also holds a master's degree in sports administration from Temple University.

He and his wife, Barbara, have a daughter, Anna, and two sons, John Michael and Sam.
