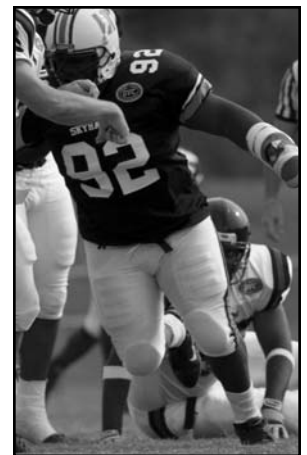

One to Watch

Ray Williams was named to the Preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference team.

He wrapped up a stellar 2007 season by claiming All-OVC honors. As a team captain, he played most of the season with a broken hand and still recorded 40 tackles and 3.5 sacks. He had six quarterback hurries and one fumble recovery.



Game Time

Kickoff is set for 6 p.m. CT at Raymond James Stadium in Tampa, Fla., with a live regional telecast on ESPN. Dave Weekley will handle the play-by-play, with Doug Graber providing the analysis.

The Series

This is the first meeting between the two teams. The University of South Florida is a member of the Big East Conference and the Bowl Championship Subdivision. UT Martin is a member of the Ohio Valley Conference and the Football Championship Subdivision. This will mark the seventh consecutive season UT Martin has played a BCS team and the third consecutive year the Skyhawks have opened the season against a BCS foe. The Skyhawks have played five BCS teams since 2002. Those teams include Arkansas State, Western Michigan, Ohio and Southern Miss.

Quick Hits

- This is the second consecutive game the Skyhawks have played in an NFL stadium. The Skyhawks closed out their 2007 campaign against Tennessee State at LP Field in Nashville. LP Field is the home of the Tennessee Titans.
- The Skyhawks welcome the addition of Ole Miss transfer Mike Hicks on Aug. 2, the day before fall camp started. Hicks, a 6-3, 215-pound wide receiver from Jacksonville, Fla., played in 10 games and had 13 catches for 225 yards. The Skyhawks also landed two junior college defenders before fall camp, Sione Fale'ofa (LB, 6-1, 240) and Johnny Sanders (S, 6-3, 205). Fale'ofa is from Los Angeles Valley Community College, while Sanders played at Copiah-Lincoln Community College in Mississippi.

PREDICTED ORDER OF FINISH ... In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head football coaches and sports information directors, Jacksonville State University has been picked as the 2008 pre-season favorite in the nine-team league. The Gamecocks claimed the 2003 and 2004 OVC Championships and were tabbed as the favorites for the second time in history (2005 was the other).

Although Jax State was tabbed as the favorites, the votes indicated the pollsters predicted this year's race should be extremely tight, as the 18 first-place votes were split evenly amongst three schools. JSU received six first-place votes and were followed by 2007 OVC Champion Eastern Kentucky, who was picked second and also received six first-place votes. Eastern Illinois, who was a 2007 at-large selection for the FCS Playoffs, also garnered six first-place votes and was tabbed third. The three teams were separated by just five points, as preseason favorite Jacksonville State ended up with 113 points, Eastern Kentucky followed with 111 points and Eastern Illinois received 108 points. It marked the closest preseason vote in Ohio Valley Conference history.

The order of finish was rounded out by Tennessee State (84 points), UT Martin (69), Tennessee Tech (55), Austin Peay (50), Murray State (36) and Southeast Missouri State (22).

FULL HOUSE OF OFFENSE ... The Skyhawks return a full-house of offense this fall with two 1,000-yard passers and three 400-yard receivers. Juniors Dexter Anoka and Cade Thompson each threw for more than a 1,000 yards in 2007. Anoka completed 58.2 percent of his passes for 1,369 yards, while Thompson, a member of the OVC's All-Newcomer squad, completed 65.3 percent of his passes for 1,034 yards. The Skyhawks also return their top three receivers in Roren Thomas, Jamaal Akbar and EJ Daniel. Thomas led the trio with 39 catches for 553 yards, while Akbar had 31 grabs for 484 yards. Daniel had 35 receptions for 434 yards.

STREAKING SKYHAWKS ... The Skyhawks closed out 2007 with three consecutive conference wins. However, the three-game victory march was not the only streak for second-year head coach Jason Simpson. The Skyhawks opened the season with a six-game slide that

included three consecutive league setbacks by a total of nine points. While the 2007 slate ended with a three-game winning streak, the season opened with four consecutive OVC losses by a total of 15 points.

BCS FOES ... The Skyhawks 2008 schedule includes two games against Bowl Championship Subdivision teams, South Florida and Auburn. The Skyhawks open the season Aug. 30 in Tampa against South Florida and will play at Auburn Nov. 8. Both South Florida and Auburn advanced to bowl games and were ranked among the top 25 teams in the nation. This is the first time in school history that UT Martin has played two BCS teams in the same season. This is also the first time in school history that the football team has played against members of the Big East Conference and the Southeastern Conference.

NEW TURF ... The Skyhawks and their 2008 foes will play on a new synthetic playing surface at Hardy M. Graham Stadium. Installation of the \$750,000 FieldTurf was completed in July by Precision Sports Fields and Hawkins Development out of Nashville. UT Martin Athletics Director Phil Dane said the Skyhawks will have the first FieldTurf field installed on a Tennessee university or college campus. FieldTurf is the same brand of synthetic turf that is in the Liberty Bowl in Memphis.

NEW COACHES ... The Skyhawks have four new coaches on this year's staff. Among the new coaches are Adam Beauchamp (defensive line and strength and conditioning coordinator); Anthony Blevins (defensive secondary and recruiting coordinator); Gerad Parker (running backs); and Cesar Rivas-Sandoval (linebackers and special teams coordinator). Along with the four newcomers, Skyhawk head coach promoted Marcus Satterfield (receivers coach and pass game coordinator) to associate head coach.

RETURNING STARTERS ... The Skyhawks return 17 starters, the third most in the Ohio Valley Conference. Among the returning offensive starters are Roren Thomas (WR), Linzy Patterson (TE), Kevin Bannon (OL), Joe Gibbs (OL), EJ Daniel (WR), Cade Thompson (QB) and Quinton Groves (OL). On defense the Skyhawks return Nate Wilson (DE), Jerrod Grace (DL), Ray Williams (DL), Craig Worthen (DE), Dorsett Pendleton (LB), Anthony Ivy (CB), Dontrell Miller (SS) and Dante Harrold (FS).

PRESEASON ALL-OVC ... Junior Roren Thomas (WR) and seniors Kevin Bannon (OL) and Ray Williams (DL) were named to the preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference team. The team was released at the league's annual media day, Tuesday, July 22 at LP Field in Nashville. Thomas led the team in receptions (39) and receiving yards (535) in 2007.

SEASON OPENERS ... The Skyhawks are 35-41-2 in season openers since 1925. This year's game against South Florida marks the fourth time in five years the Skyhawks have opened the season against a BCS team. The Skyhawks are 0-3 in season openers against BCS teams.

AGAINST TEAMS FROM THE SUNSHINE STATE ...

This year's season opener against South Florida marks the first time the Skyhawks have played against a team from the state of Florida since 1970 when the team played Pensacola Navy. The Skyhawks are 2-0 against teams from Florida with a pair of victories over Pensacola Navy. The opener will mark only the second time in school history that UT Martin has played in the state of Florida. The last time UT Martin played in Florida was in 1970 when the team beat Pensacola Navy.

WATCH THOSE NAMES ... The Skyhawks enter the 2008 season with two Daniels (Erick Daniel and EJ Daniel), four Joneses (Jimmy Jones, Karlos Jones, Garrick Jones and Kenny Jones), two McNairs (Julius and Jason) and an Ivy (Anthony) and Ivey (Adam). None of the players with the same last name are brothers. The McNairs are cousins and Jason McNair is the nephew of NFL quarterback Steve McNair while Julius McNair is the former NFL signal caller's cousin.

PRESEASON POLLS ... UT Martin was picked 21st in the FCS in Phil Steele's annual preseason magazine. UT Martin also received some votes in the annual SME (Sports Media Entertainment) Network Preseason Top 25 Broadcasters' Poll.

FORMER NFL QBs VISIT ... Former NFL quarterbacks Steve McNair and Neil O'Donnell have made recent visits to UT Martin. McNair was on campus earlier this month to visit his nephew freshman Jason McNair. O'Donnell was on campus to celebrate the recent FieldTurf installation at Hardy M. Graham. O'Donnell is a sales representative for FieldTurf.

PAT STREAK ... Skyhawk senior Tom Hansen ended the 2007 season by making 24 consecutive extra points. His last miss was in the first quarter of the game at Eastern Illinois on Oct. 20, 2007. Hansen tied a school record for most PATs made in a game when he recorded 10 extra points against

OUR NAME ... The name of our institution is The University of Tennessee at Martin. It is acceptable to refer to us as UT Martin or UTM in subsequent references. UT-Martin, UT, Martin and Tennessee Martin should never be used.

A SKYHAWK ... A new era began in 1995 as UT Martin officially launched its Skyhawk nickname. A group of wise thinkers captured UT Martin's history in a three-fold manner:

- The school's athletic teams were called "sky pilots," a frontier term for preachers in that day.
- During World War II, UT Junior College contracted with the Naval War Training Service to help train pilots, who completed their flight training
- Red-tail hawks are indigenous to the West Tennessee region.

Murray State. The senior from Knoxville also set a new UT Martin school record for most PATs made in a single season (42).

UT Martin head football coach Jason Simpson believes in winning. In only two seasons at the helm of the Skyhawks, Simpson has won 13 games and piloted the Skyhawks into the upper echelon of the Football Championship Subdivision.

Under the direction of Simpson, the Skyhawks closed out their 2007 season with three consecutive wins and winning four of their last five Ohio Valley Conference games to finish a respectable fourth in the league standings.

Offensively, the Skyhawks were one of the best in the OVC and among the nation's most potent attacks.

Led by All-American tailback Don Chapman, the Skyhawks were ranked among the top 35 teams in the nation in eight offensive statistical categories. The Skyhawks were 13th in the nation in total offense, averaging 430.55 yards per game. They were 19th in the country in scoring offense averaging 33.36 points per game.

In the OVC, the Skyhawks were ranked first in six offensive stat categories (scoring, total offense, total offense per play, total offensive yards per game, total offensive touchdowns and pass efficiency). The Skyhawks were ranked second in the 10-team league in three more offensive stat categories (touchdowns scored, rushing offense and yards per rush).

The Skyhawks soared in the OVC victory over arch-rival Murray State this past season, setting several league records en route to a convincing 76-34 victory. The Skyhawks tied a conference record with their 76 points and set new marks for most yards rushing (821) and best rushing yards average (10.6 per carry).

While Simpson is faced with replacing Chapman in the backfield this season, he can rely on junior quarterback Cade Thompson from Maryville, Tenn. Thompson was named to the OVC's All-Newcomer team in 2007. He completed 81-of 124 passes (65.3 percent) for 1,034 yards and eight touchdowns. The Skyhawks also return All-OVC selections Ray Williams (DL), and Kevin Bannon (OL).

Simpson lived up to his winning ways in 2006, his first season as the head coach at UT Martin. He came to campus and immediately started talking about winning an Ohio Valley Conference championship. By the end of November, the Skyhawks won their first OVC title and found themselves playing in the Football Championship first round.

The Skyhawks posted a 9-3 overall record and a 6-1 mark in the OVC standings. The overall worksheet was the best for the Skyhawks since 1988 when they advance to postseason play as a Division II team. The six OVC victories were the most for the Skyhawks since joining the league in 1992. Of the nine victories, five were road wins and it marked the first time the Skyhawks won an OVC road game since 1996.

Along with victories, Simpson led the Skyhawks to national rankings for the first time since 1989 and top 10 statistical rankings in pass efficiency defense (2), total defense (6) and pass defense (7). The team was 12th in rushing offense while running back Don Chapman was ranked No. 9 in rushing offense (128.36 yards per game). Junior Jessie Burton was ranked seventh in kickoff returns (26.2 yards per

return).

Simpson finished fourth in the annual voting for the Eddie Robinson Award, the nation's best coach. He was named the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year and he earned the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year trophy.

BEFORE UT MARTIN

Before accepting his first head coaching job at UT Martin, Simpson was the offensive coordinator at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. He was instrumental in the resurgence of the UTC football program. In 2005, Chattanooga posted a 6-5 campaign, the school's first winning season since 1997.

At Chattanooga, Simpson coached quarterback Cedric Stevens who threw for more than 3,100 yards with a 66 percent completion percentage. With 20 touchdown passes, Stevens was named national Division I-AA Player of the Week. Stevens turned in a stellar effort with 540 yards of passing and five touchdowns as he helped Chattanooga pile up 697 yards of total offense in a 59-56 win over Appalachian State.

In 2004, Simpson's offense finished 14th in Division I-AA for passing and 32nd in scoring with 29.2 points per game.

Simpson also coached Alonzo Nix at Chattanooga. Nix broke the Southern Conference record for receptions in a season with 90 catches. He earned all-conference honors in 2003 and 2004. In 2003 he was an All-American and in 2004 he was a preseason Walter Payton Award finalist.

Before Chattanooga, Simpson coached at Texas State University, a member of the Southland Football League. He coached quarterbacks, receivers and served as the team's recruiting coordinator.

At Texas State, Simpson coached Tyson Olvo who is the school's third all-time receptions leader. In 2000, Texas State posted a 7-4 record, the school's first winning season in 10 years.

Simpson also served as an assistant coach from 1997-1999 at Jacksonville State University. He coached quarterbacks and was the team's passing game coordinator. He also coached receivers and served as an assistant special teams coordinator.

He was a member of the Jacksonville State staff responsible for the third best turnaround in Division I football for the 1997 and 1998 seasons.

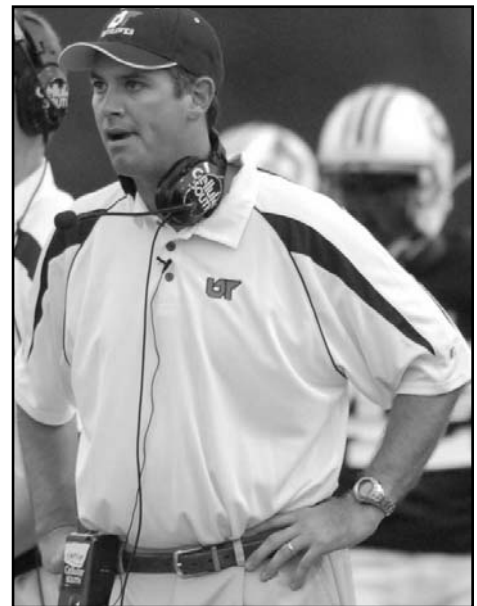
ABOUT THE SKYHAWK HEAD COACH

Simpson is a native of Ellisville, Miss. He signed as a quarterback with Mississippi State and played for two seasons for the Bulldogs. He also played baseball for Ron Polk at State before transferring to Southern Miss in 1992.

At Southern Miss, Simpson was a two-time all-conference selection in baseball and was team captain his senior season. After earning a bachelor's degree in 1994 from Southern Miss, he spent the next year as a graduate assistant football coach at Delta State, where he coached defensive backs.

In the spring of 1995, Simpson served as an assistant football and head baseball coach at Collins High School in Mississippi.

Simpson and his wife, the former Julie Wilkerson, have a son and a daughter: Ty, 5 years old, and Emma, 3 years old.
