



## Georgia State Athletics Football Training Facility Fact Sheet

### I. General Facts

- Acreage location: 188 Martin Luther King Drive, Atlanta, GA  
By railroad tracks used during Civil War and now existing MARTA line  
Some original brick and stonework from existing building saved to give facility a unique look  
Building is three blocks from GSU Sports Arena  
Georgia Capitol Gold Dome and city skyline view from fields  
Groundbreaking ceremony was Nov. 20, 2008  
First practice on fields was March 29, 2010  
First practice using new locker rooms – August 4, 2011

## **II. Field Components**

### Exterior

- a. Synthetic Field
  - i. Full length field – 120 yards with two goal posts
  - ii. Netting behind each goal post is 40 x 40 feet
  - iii. Astro Turf Game Day Grass 3D 60 w/ an 80/20 infill mix of rubber and sand
- b. Natural Field
  - i. Half length field - 60 yard field with one goal post
  - ii. Netting behind goal post is 40 x 40 feet
  - iii. Tifton 419 Bermuda Grass
- c. Parking
  - i. 26 parking spots in front of building
- d. Loading Dock
  - i. Large enough for two trucks at one time (football and band can load together)

## **III. Building Components**

1. Breakout Meeting Rooms
  - 8 total, plus the main team room and its partition to make two rooms
  - Main Conference Room and Coach Curry Office
2. Locker Room
  - Player Lockers – Laser-etched with Panther logo
    - 114 Lockers
    - 30” x 24” x 78”
    - Power ventilated lockers, all with an individual fan to assist with drying of shoes, helmets and shoulder pads
    - Fans will be controlled by a timer in the equipment room
  - Coaches Lockers
    - Separated in two areas, male and female locker rooms
    - 18” x 24” x 78”
    - 30 total lockers
    - Solid wood lockers

- Mondo Flooring
  - Showers and restrooms
  - Main gathering entrance with locker cubbies for each player to turn in and pick up clothing and laundry.
3. Equipment Room
- High Density storage system to store equipment
  - Two 100lb Washers and one 60lb washer
  - Two 125lb Dryers and one 75lb dryer
4. Training Room
- 5 taping stations
  - 8 treatment tables
  - Private physician exam room
  - Rehab areas
  - Storage rolling shelving
  - Water area for coolers and tubs
5. Hydro Therapy Room
- Polar Plunge (7'-6" x 7'-6" x 3' x 10")
    - 750 gallons of 50 degree water
  - HydroWorx 500 Series Pool
    - 2,100 gallons of heated water w/ submerged treadmill and resistance jets
6. Main entrance, lobby and hallways
- Reception counter
  - New artwork to embellish the GSU football motif and inaugural year
  - Restrooms
7. Band Storage Area
- Two levels
  - Individual Lockers to store musical instruments
  - Band Uniform storage
  - Office space for directors
