**CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES**

- Alcorn State suffered its first conference road loss since a 28-21 defeat at Grambling State on Oct. 11, 2014. The Braves didn't lose an away game in league play last season, but fell at Grambling once again this past Saturday snapping a seven game road conference winning streak
- Texas Southern is off to its best start since 2014. The Tigers (2-2, 2-1) opened that season at 5-0 before losing six of its last seven finishing at 5-6
- Grambling State and Prairie View A&M combined to score 124 points with GSU winning 70-54 in 2015. The most since a 1998 55-40 victory also in favor of the Tigers. A potential third win in a row over PVAMU would be the most since GSU rolled off 21 straight from 1987-2008
- Alcorn State has never played the University of Arkansas as this is also only their third time facing a school from the Southeastern Conference. As a league, the SWAC is 0-6 versus the SEC
- Record Watch: Southern running back Lenard Tillery now has 3,678 career rushing yards. He now only needs 372 yards to become the SWAC's all-time leader. Tillery is only one of 14 rushers from the league to gain over 3,000 career rushing yards since 1970
- Arkansas-Pine Bluff's last win over Alabama State came in 2012. The Golden Lions eventually went on to win the 2012 SWAC Football Championship
- The last time Mississippi Valley State played Jackson State on the road, the Delta Devils gave then first year head coach Ricky Comegy his second win of the season over his former JSU Tigers in 2014
- Alabama State is off to its worst start in 17 seasons. The last time the Hornets start off at 0-4 was 1999
- Brothers Hurts: Texas Southern starting quarterback Averion Hurts is the older brother of Jalen Hurts, starting QB at the University of Alabama. The two have combined for 19 TD's through four weeks. This week, TSU is facing a school from Alabama as they'll host Alabama A&M
- Grambling State WR Chad Williams is ranked first in the nation in receptions per game with an average of 11 per outing while rival wide-out Willie Quinn of Southern leads the FCS in receiving yards with a total of 483

## PRESEASON ALL SWAC/ ALL AMERICANS

• The Southwestern Athletic Conference released its 2016 SWAC Preseason Teams with Southern running back Leonard Tillery and Alabama State linebacker Kourtney Berry being tabbed for individual honors.

The teams were released during the 2016 SWAC Football Media Day after ballots were completed by the league's head coaches and sports information directors. Fifty-one players were named to this year's preseason teams, with several returning players that earned all-conference at the conclusion of the 2015 season. Should a player that was named to the first team during the postseason not return, the second-team player for that position was elevated to the first team. Players were ranked in their position based on the number of votes received.

After leading the league in rushing en route to a second-straight first-team All-SWAC nod, Tillery was the voters' favorite for the SWAC Preseason Offensive Player of the Year award. For the third-straight year, Berry was tabbed as SWAC Preseason Defensive Player of the Year.

Tillery rushed for 1,211 yards on 197 carries (6.1 average) in 2015, scoring a SWAC-best 14 touchdowns on the

ground for the Jaguars. He was the only runner to average 100 yards or better a game, posting an average of 110.1 yards per contest.

The Baton Rouge, La. native is one of five Southern players on the preseason first-team offense, with quarterback Austin Howard, offensive linemen Anthony Mosley and Terrell Lee, tight end Dillon Beard and return specialist Willie Quinn. Rounding out the first-team offense are running back Martez Carter (Grambling State), offensive linemen Detonio Dade (Alcorn State), Justin Miller (Grambling State), Josiah Freeman (Prairie View A&M), and wide receivers Chad Williams (Grambling State) and Daniel Williams (Jackson State).

Berry, who won the 2015 SWAC Defensive Player of the Year award, has led the SWAC in stops during each of his first three seasons. The Merrillville, Ind. product accounted for a league-best 130 tackles and two fumble recoveries. He is a three-time First Team All-SWAC performer and has earned several pre-and post-season honors.

**SWAC lands four on STATS FCS Preseason All-America Team**

The Southwestern Athletic Conference lands four (Kourtney Berry-Alabama State, Martez Carter-Grambling State, Javancy Jones-Jackson State and Willie Quinn-Southern) on the 2016 STATS FCS All-America Team. The announcement was made Monday morning.

Quinn was selected as a preseason First Team All-America selection as a kick returner. Quinn is one of the most feared return specialists in the country. In 2015, the 5-5, 145-pound speedster was a first-team All-SWAC honoree, he returned 25 kickoffs for 28.8 yards and four touchdowns in addition to running back seven punts at a 5.6 yard clips and another score. Quinn also hauled in 49 receptions for 592 yards three touchdowns. In all, he accounted for 1,350 all-purpose yards and 8 touchdowns.

Berry, a second team All-America option won the 2015 SWAC Defensive Player of the Year award has led the SWAC in tackles during each of his first three seasons. The Merrillville, Ind. product accounted for a league-best 130 tackles and two fumble recoveries. He is a three-time First Team All-SWAC performer and has earned several pre-and post-season honors. Berry is among eight returning starters from one of the league's best defenses as the Hornets ranked second in scoring (24.8 ppg), first against the run (142.4 ypg), fifth against the pass (222.8 ypg) and second in total defense (365.2 ypg).

Jones and Carter were both third team selections. Jones ended the 2015 campaign with 107 tackles, 7.5 sacks and led the nation with 25.5 stops in behind the line of scrimmage. In the final two games of last season, Jones, who battled various injuries throughout the season, posted 28 tackles, 9.5 for loss, 2.5 sacks and two forced fumbles.

## 2016 TOYOTA SWAC FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

The SWAC Football Championship Game began in 1999, with conference teams beginning play in an East-West divisional format, allowing division winners to meet on the field to decide a champion.

Through an agreement forged with the City of Birmingham, Ala. the Southwestern Athletic Conference staged its first championship game at historic Legion Field.

On Saturday, December 11, 1999, the Jackson State University Tigers (East Champion) and the Southern University Jaguars (West Champion) kicked off the inaugural Southwestern Athletic Conference Football Championship game.

In a thriller, Southern came from behind for a 31-30 win. In 13 years of the SWAC Championship Game, eight of the 10 conference schools have earned a berth to play for the title, with the last two SWAC champions being first-time participants in Prairie View A&M and Texas Southern.

From the Western Division, Grambling State has earned a trip to the championship six times – the most of any SWAC school – and posts a 6-1 record.

Southern has played in the title game three times with a 2-1 record, while Arkansas-Pine Bluff has made two appearances capturing

its first outright league title in football in 2012. Prairie View A&M and Texas Southern have each made an appearance.

Alabama A&M has represented the Eastern Division five times and posted a 1-4 record in the championship game.

Alabama State is 1-3 in its four appearances, while Jackson State is 1-4 in four championship games. Mississippi Valley State is the only school that has never appeared in the SWAC Championship Game.

In May of 2013, The Southwestern Athletic Conference Council of Presidents and Chancellors voted unanimously to relocate the 2013 Toyota SWAC Football Championship to Houston, Texas. The football championship game is held at NRG Stadium which is home of the NFL's Houston Texans.
