GAME NOTES

- Oklahoma's starting lineup against Midwestern State: Gabbi Ortiz (G), Gioya Carter (G), Peyton Little (G), Maddie Manning (G) and Vionise Pierre-Louis (C).
- Attendance for Wednesday's game was 3,157.
- 14 OU players played in the opening half against the Mustangs, including nine in the first quarter.
- Five Sooners (Vionise Pierre-Louis – 17, Chelsea Dungee – 15, Peyton Little – 11, Gioya Carter – 10, Gabbi Ortiz – 10) registered double-digit scoring in the win.
- Freshmen Chelsea Dungee and Nancy Mulkey made their collegiate debuts for the Sooners. Dungee scored 15 points off the bench, finishing 4-of-6 from the field and 6-of-10 from the free throw line in 16 minutes. Mulkey scored two points, recorded four rebounds and chipped in three blocks in 12 minutes of action.
- Vionise Pierre-Louis led all scorers with 17 points on 8-of-10 shooting in 17 minutes. The junior center also added in a game-high six rebounds.
- The Sooners registered a 2-1 assist-to-turnover ratio, logging 18 assists to just nine turnovers, while forcing 35 turnovers from the Bulldogs. OU scored 57 points off of Midwestern State turnovers and collected 27 steals in the exhibition victory.
