### MILESTONES

Jessica Féquière crossed the 100 career point barrier with her first basket of the game against Army. She also had a career-high 18 points, leading the Great Danes to victory over a Black Knights team that had beaten the Great Danes by three the year before. Senior Cassandra Edwards also had a career-high in points with 14. In the following game against Boston University, Edwards grabbed her 100th defensive rebound. At Fordham, Bose Aiyalogbe made her 50th career appearance and grabbed her 100th career rebound, Carter grabbed her 150th offensive rebound, Heather Forster made her 10th career start,

### TRIPLE THREAT

During the game against Miami, senior Imani Tate crossed three career milestone thresholds. She played in her 100th game, she grabbed her 500th rebound, and she recorded her 200th steal. Tate needs just nine more field goals to hit 500, and nine more offensive rebounds to hit 200. Junior Tiana-Jo Carter also reeled in her 200th career defensive rebound against Kentucky.

### UALBANY EARNS TWO 2015-16 AE YEARLY AWARDS

Shereesha Richards won her third consecutive America East Player of the Year Award, the latest in her long list of accolades. She also earned spots on the All-Conference First and Defensive Teams, and was named the America East Tournament Most Outstanding Player.

Tiana-Jo Carter was named America East Sixth Player of the year, after being named to the All-Rookie team two seasons ago.

Imani Tate, like Richards, earned spots on the All-Conference First and Defensive Teams, while Zakiya Saunders earned an All-Conference Second Team selection.

### UALBANY RANKED NINTH IN MID-MAJOR POLL

The Great Danes were picked ninth in the preseason Mid-Major poll. The team surpasses their preseason ranking of 14 from a year ago, before the Great Danes went on to win their fifth consecutive America East championship.

UAlbany, which tallied 470 points, is the only America East squad in the rankings, and one of two schools, along with Iona, from New York.

South Dakota State earned 742 points overall, and 26 first place selections as the top ranked school in the poll. Second-ranked Green Bay and fifth-ranked Gonzaga received two first-place votes each, and tenth-ranked Princeton received one. Star Seniors

### UALBANY PICKED AS AMERICA EAST FAVORITE

The Great Danes were selected first in the preseason conference coaches' poll for the fifth consecutive season. UAlbany received five of a possible eight first-place votes, accumulating 60 points total.

UMBC, Maine, and Binghamton were selected second, third, and fourth respectively, with only four points separating the three teams. UMBC and Maine received two first-place votes each.

#### TATE NAMED PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

2016-17 is the second consecutive season Tate has been named to the preseason team. Last season, Tate was named to the America East All-Conference First Team and All-Defensive team. The year before, Tate was named America East Sixth Player of the Year, and selected for the America East All-Conference Second Team and the All-Tournament Team.

#### ROAD TRIPPING

Only five of UAlbany's non-conference games will be played at SEFCU Arena. The remaining eight will be road trips, including the opening weekend in Lexington, Kentucky, where the Great Danes will face the host Wildcats and then the Miami (FL) Hurricanes as part of the Kentucky Classic. Other road swings include Fordham, St. John's, and Yale.

#### MORE HISTORY

The Great Danes made program history last year by winning their first-ever NCAA tournament game. They made conference history by winning a fifth-consecutive title, a feat unmatched by any women's or men's America East team. UAlbany looks to extend their historical streak while defending their five-straight titles.

#### JET SETTING

Five of the 13 women on the UAlbany roster hail from international countries. Two of this year's freshmen, Mackenzie Trpcic (Canada) and Kumsal Aslan (Turkey) join a squad of players that includes Bose Aiyalogbe (Nigeria), Cassandra Edwards (Canada), and Jessica Féquière (Canada). In recent years, the Great Danes have also fielded players from the British Virgin Islands, Jamaica, and New Zealand.

#### UALBANY HOSTS ALBANY CUP

The Women's Albany Cup, the annual matchup between local rivals UAlbany and Siena, will be held at SEFCU Arena for the first time in history. Traditionally, the game is held in the Times Union Center. The last time Siena played a game at UAlbany was February 2, 1981. Last year, the Great Danes defeated the Saints 61-42, the sixth year in a row UAlbany has claimed victory in the Albany Cup.

### **SCOUTING BOSTON UNIVERSITY**

The Terriers have opened the season with two consecutive losses, to Boston-area rivals Northeastern and Boston College. Two BU players, Sarah Hope and Kara Sheftic, are averaging double-digit points per game, but the team is only shooting 39% from the floor so far this season.

### **CLIMBING THE RANKS**

Imani Tate ranks sixth all-time in program history in career scoring, 12th in steals, 14th in assists, and 18th in rebounds. Tiana-Jo Carter ranks 10th in program history in career blocks. Last season, Tate surpassed the 1,000-point barrier, and needs 436 points to pass Ebone Henry for second place in program history. Shereesha Richards' program record is 1,233 points away.

### **EMPIRE**

Six of UAlbany's 13 non-conference games will be played against opponents from New York State. Additionally, the Great Danes will play two games each against in-state rivals Binghamton and Stony Brook, meaning New York schools account for 10 of UAlbany's 29 regular-season matchups.

# 2016-17 UALBANY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

## LAST TIME OUT

**BRONX, N.Y.** – Returning to the road after two games at home, the University at Albany women's basketball program (2-3) visited Fordham (3-1) on Tuesday, falling to the Rams in double-overtime 89-82 in the Danes' most tightly-contested game so far this season.

"Hopefully we take away how important it is to make defensive stops in key situations," said head coach Joanna Bernabei-McNamee. "I thought we had opportunities to make defensive stops and close the game out, but we didn't capitalize on our chances."

After one, the Great Danes trailed 23-19. Despite the deficit, the team shot 64.3% from the floor. Jessica Féquière led the way with six points, and Imani Tate had five. All five UAlbany starters scored in the first quarter.

The Great Danes took the lead with just under five minutes remaining in the second quarter when Tate hit a three-pointer to give the team a 29-27 lead.

UAlbany took a 38-37 lead into halftime. Tate led the Danes in scoring with 13. Mackenzie Trpcic had five assists. Tiana-Jo Carter and Cassandra Edwards each had four points off the bench. The team as a whole shot 54.8% from the floor in the first half, and outscored Fordham 24-12 in points in the paint.

The Danes opened the second half on a 6-0 run, taking a 44-37 lead, forcing Fordham to take a timeout. Bose Aiyalogbe extended the run to 8-0 before Fordham scored again.

Fordham tied the game at 48 with just over two minutes remaining in the third quarter, before Carter hit a turn-around jumper in the paint to give the Danes back the lead. After Fordham tied the game at 50, Tate went on a personal 4-0 run, eclipsing the 20-point mark for the third time in four games, to give the Danes a 54-50 lead after three.

Carter scored her 10th point of the game with just under eight minutes remaining in the fourth quarter.

Fordham tied the game at 66 with 57 seconds remaining with a three-pointer.

Tate went down to the other end and hit a four-foot jumper with 40 seconds left. Trpcic was fouled with 16.5 seconds left with a chance to ice the game from the free throw line. She made one of two, leaving the Danes with a three-point lead.

Fordham hit two free throws to bring the game within one with 9.7 remaining. The Rams fouled Féquière on the inbounds play, and she proceeded to sink both free throws. Fordham tied the game on a three with eight-tenths of a second left. A turnover on the inbounds play meant the no time ran off the clock, giving Fordham a chance to win in regulation, which came up short on a deflected inbounds pass to the three-point line.

By the end of regulation, Tate, Carter, and Féquière had all scored in double figures.

Fordham took the lead 80-78 with 1:01 remaining in the first overtime. Carter tied the game with a layup with 6.2 seconds left. In the ensuing possession, Fordham drove to the basket and Tate came from the help side to block the attempt out of bounds. After tying up the ball on the next inbounds play, the Great Danes won possession, with a second left, sending the game into a second overtime with the score knotted at 80.

Tate had scored 29 points. Carter matched her career-high with 18. Féquière and Aiyalogbe each had eight rebounds, and Tate and Trpcic each had five assists. Carter had five blocks.

Fordham started the second overtime on a 7-2 run within the first two and a half minutes. The Rams outscored the Great Danes 9-2 in the second overtime to win the game 89-82.

"At times I thought we responded well," said Coach Mac, commenting on the contentious nature of the game. "I thought the bench stayed very positive and motivated. They definitely brought the energy. But if we're going to grow from this loss it needs to be in stepping up and making defensive stops."

Tate ended the game with 31 points. Aiyalogbe grabbed nine rebounds. The team shot 51.4% from the floor for the game, and outscored the Rams 48-22 in points in the paint, and 22-15 in bench points. Four Rams scored in double figures, and they held the advantage in points off of turnovers 20-12, and second chance points 19-13.

Next up, the Great Danes will host the Albany Cup against Siena for the first time ever at SEFCU Arena. Tipoff is scheduled for 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, November 27. The men will also host Siena following the women's game, at 7:00 p.m.

"I told the team in the locker room that it hurts to lose, especially after working so hard," said Coach Mac. "So we want to let that feeling resonate so we don't let it happen again. Moving forward, offensively we played well enough to win, we just have to do a better job defensively."

# 2016-17 UALBANY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

## LAST TIME vs. SIENA

**ALBANY, N.Y.** – The UAlbany women's basketball team played stellar defense to keep the Albany Cup with the Great Danes for the sixth year in a row, taking down Siena 61-42 at the Times Union Center on Saturday night.

UAlbany (7-2) held Siena (4-6) to just 12 points on four field goals in the first half. Imani Tate and Zakiya Saunders combined to shoot 64% and took command in the second half as UAlbany led wire-to-wire the whole game.

"We did a good job of playing team defense with our presses and at the half-court," said UAlbany head coach Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, whose UAlbany teams have never lost to Siena. "[Shereesha Richards] did not have a big scoring night, but everyone stepped up and got her points."

With the victory, UAlbany improves to 7-6 against in Division I play against its crosstown rival, taking the last six contests. The Great Danes had 11 steals on 27 Siena turnovers, outrebounded the Saints 33-26 and held their opponent to 32.6% shooting.

Tate had a huge night for UAlbany with 27 points off 11-16 shooting, adding nine rebounds, five steals and three assists.

"We are a defensive team, we go based on our defense," said Tate. "When that works, it makes our offense go."

Saunders added 12 points off 5-9 from the field, four assists and two steals. Tiana-Jo Carter finished with nine points and nine rebounds while Shereesha Richards tallied a career-high five assists with six points and four rebounds.

For Siena, Kollins Scarbrough concluded with a team-high 13 points and three steals. Margot Hetzke, the 2014-15 MAAC Rookie of the Year, was held to two points with 10 rebounds.

UAlbany scored on its first three possessions off quick strike baskets by Richards and Tate. Saunders added a kick-out jumper as UAlbany took an 8-0 lead to start the first. Siena kept throwing up shots from behind the arc, hitting a couple to pull within two.

The Great Danes zone defense kept Siena out of the paint, forcing the home team to shoot long range jumpers. UAlbany attacked the paint, building the lead up with a Heather Forster layup and a Saunders fast break layup off a Richards steal. UAlbany led 12-8 after the first quarter.

UAlbany's defense kept going with the zone and the halfcourt traps, keeping Siena without a field goal for almost the entire second quarter. The Great Danes, trying to break the Siena double teams in the paint, used jumpers by Tate and Saunders to increase the lead.

Tate, Saunders and Carter also added free throws down the stretch as the defense forced missed shots and shot clock violations. A Siena three in the closing seconds of the half made the score UAlbany 21-12.

Capped by a halfcourt steal and score by Tate, UAlbany began the third on a 6-0 run. Some back and forth scoring commenced as both sides looked for points from underneath the basket.

Towards the end of the third quarter, Erin Coughlin buried the three to start a small run for UAlbany. The streak was aided by Tate earning a personal 6-0 run, twice stealing the ball at the half court line and hitting the layup on a fast break. UAlbany led 42-25 going into the fourth quarter.

UAlbany looked to slow the pace down in the fourth and focused on using up the clock and going into the paint. Tate and Carter hit jumpers to build the UAlbany advantage to 46-25 in the quarter's first two minutes.

Siena looked to the perimeter for its shots, hitting two as they traded them for layups by UAlbany. On a three-pointer from Denisha Petty-Evans off a turnover, the home team pulled to within 17 at 54-37 with four minutes remaining.

Tate and Carter kept the lead strong with late baskets as the defense held off Siena to a pair of baskets in the final four minutes. UAlbany took the 61-42 victory at the TU Center.

UAlbany will go wheels up next weekend to compete in the Women of Troy Classic in Los Angeles, California. The Great Danes take on UC Davis on Friday, December 18th at 11 p.m. ET (8 p.m. PT) in the semifinals of the tournament.

# 2016-17 UALBANY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

## COACH JOANNA BERNABEI-MCNAMEE - FIRST SEASON AT UALBANY



University at Albany Director of Athletics Mark Benson announced Friday, April 15th, 2016 the hiring of Joanna Bernabei-McNamee as the 11th head women's basketball coach in program history and fourth head coach in the Great Danes' Division I era.

Bernabei-McNamee (pronounced Bern-uh-BEE Mac-Na-MEE), a native of Weirton, W.Va., comes to UAlbany after three seasons as the head coach of the University of Pikeville in Pikeville, Ky. There, McNamee racked up 63 wins and led the program to back-to-back National Tournament berths, including a program-record 26 victories and an NAIA Final Four appearance in 2016. McNamee was named

the 2016 Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) NAIA Regional Coach of the Year, and was also named the 2015 Mid-South Conference Coach of the Year.

Prior to Pikeville, McNamee coached at the NCAA Division I level for 10 years. She served as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Maryland for four seasons from 2003 to 2007, and helped pilot the Terrapins to the 2006 National Championship. Maryland beat Duke 78-75 in overtime for the title and finished with a record of 34-4. During her tenure, she brought in four straight nationally ranked recruiting classes, including three in the top 10.

McNamee spent two years at West Virginia University as an assistant coach where she was a scout, position coach and recruiting coordinator. Before her time as a Mountaineer, McNamee had a two-year stint at Eastern Kentucky where she was responsible for scouting, individual player development, as well as serving as the recruiting coordinator.

Coach Mac gained head coaching experience in 1998 at West Virginia Wesleyan where she compiled an 18-9 record and a third-place finish in the West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WVIAC), while also acting as the school's Senior Women's Administrator.

McNamee attended West Liberty State where she was a Division II All-American and a four-time first-team All-WVIAC selection as a point guard. Named the 1997 WVIAC Player of the Year, she still holds the NCAA Division II career assists record of 1,107 and the record for assists in a game with 24. She is one of only four players in NCAA history to record over 1,000 points and 1,000 assists, finishing her stellar career with 1,317 total points.

McNamee also holds NCAA records for average assists per game (9.5), and the school and conference marks for assists in a game, season (294) and career. She led her team to an 80-36 record over four years and is listed on West Liberty's Top 20 All-Time Best Athletes list. She was the first woman to be named first-team All-West Virginia Athletic Conference for four years and was inducted into the West Liberty State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2002 and the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference Hall of Fame in 2011.

McNamee earned her bachelor's degree in exercise physiology in 1997 from West Liberty and a master's degree from Eastern Kentucky in sports administration in 1999.

Joanna and her husband Joe McNamee have two sons, Luke (9) and Caden (8). McNamee took a nearly four-year hiatus from coaching (2009-13) to focus on raising her children.

Coach Mac takes over a UAlbany program that has won a combined nine America East Conference tournament and regular season titles in the last five seasons, and has made five consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. In the 2015-16 season, UAlbany defeated No. 5 Florida for the program's first-ever Division I NCAA Tournament victory.
