



# OKLAHOMA BASKETBALL

NOV. 27, 2016 • #13/12 OKLAHOMA 70, COLORADO STATE 55 • POSTGAME NOTES

## TEAM NOTES

- No. 13/12 Oklahoma continued its undefeated start to the 2016-17 season on Sunday with a 70-55 victory over Colorado State at Lloyd Noble Center. Maddie Manning led the Sooners with 16 points, and Chelsea Dungee added in 10 in her first career start. The Sooners improved to 5-0, while Colorado State dropped to 2-3 this season.
- The Sooners pulled away in the third quarter, beginning the second half with a nearly flawless frame. OU outscored Colorado State, 28-13, in the third quarter, shooting 12-for-16 (.750) from the field to begin the second half. OU scored 28 points in the third quarter, tying for the second-most scored by OU in a single frame over the last two seasons. Manning scored 12 of her 16 points in the quarter as OU stretched its lead to 23 points with 0:37 to go in the frame.
- OU is now 2-1 against Colorado State in three meetings and the Sooners are 2-0 against the Rams in Norman. Sunday's game marked the first matchup between the two programs since Jan. 10, 1987. The Sooners also improved to 14-6 against current members of the Mountain West Conference.
- The Sooners moved to 3-0 this year when posting a better shooting percentage than their opponent. Against the Rams, Oklahoma finished 22-of-52 (.423) from the floor, 6-for-21 (.286) from 3-point range and 20-for-25 (.800) from the free throw line. OU has won 24 straight games when finishing with a better shooting percentage than its foe.
- Oklahoma finished the month of November undefeated for the first time since the 2010-11 season. Dating back to last year, OU has won nine straight games in November.
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, OU is 27-4 overall and 12-1 against non-conference opponents at Lloyd Noble Center.
- OU's starting lineup vs. Colorado State -- T'ona Edwards (G), Chelsea Dungee (G), Peyton Little (G), Maddie Manning (G), Vionise Pierre-Louis (C). Dungee received her first career start against Colorado State, while T'ona Edwards made her third career start for the Sooners.
- Oklahoma head coach Sherri Coale is now 447-217 in her 21 seasons with the Sooners.

## INDIVIDUAL NOTES

### CHELSEA DUNGEE

- Finished in double figures for the first time in her OU career, scoring 10 points on 4-of-9 shooting. Recorded her first career 3-pointer in the first quarter and finished 2-for-4 from beyond the arc in the win in 20 minutes of action.

### PEYTON LITTLE

- Scored nine points against Colorado State and sits points away from 1,000 career points between Oklahoma and Texas A&M.

### MADDIE MANNING

- Finished in double figures for the third consecutive game, scoring a season-high 16 points on 5-of-12 shooting. The 12 field goal attempts tied a career-high for Manning and her 16 points rank as the second-most she has scored in a single game during her OU career. The Sooners are 4-1 all-time when Manning leads the team in scoring. Manning was also a perfect 6-for-6 from the free throw line against the Rams.
- Nearly set a career-high in rebounds, finishing with a season-best nine boards against Colorado State to lead the Sooners. OU is 4-4 all-time when Manning leads the team in rebounding.
- Averaging 14.0 points and 5.3 rebounds per contest over the last three games.

### NANCY MULKEY

- Scored a season-high six points and tied for the team lead with two blocks. Mulkey hit her first two free throw attempts in the fourth quarter and finished 2-for-3 from the field in 10 minutes of action.

### VIONISE PIERRE-LOUIS

- Leads Oklahoma with 52 rebounds (10.4 per game) through five games. The 52 boards for the junior are the most by an OU player through five games to begin a season since Amanda Thompson pulled down 51 start the 2009-10 season.
- Recorded two blocks in Sunday's win to bring her career total to 83 rejections. Pierre-Louis is just one block shy of tying Lisa Allison and Jacquetta Hurley for seventh place in OU career history.

### LANESIA WILLIAMS

- Scored a season-high seven points off the bench in 16 minutes of action.
