



# OKLAHOMA BASKETBALL

**DEC. 1, 2016 • #17/20 KENTUCKY 82, #12/12 OKLAHOMA 68 • POSTGAME NOTES**

## TEAM NOTES

- No. 12/12 Oklahoma suffered its first loss of the season Thursday night, falling 82-68 on the road to No. 17/20 Kentucky in the 2016 SEC/Big 12 Challenge at Memorial Coliseum. The Sooners fell to 5-1, while Kentucky improved to 6-1 overall. The Wildcats now lead the all-times series, 3-1.
- For the first time this season, four Sooners scored in double figures. Three players - Peyton Little (19), Gioya Carter (18) and Chelsea Dungee (12) finished with season-high scoring totals in the loss.
- The Sooners recorded a season-high 11 3-pointers against Kentucky, their most in a single game since hitting 10 at Baylor (Jan. 3, 2016) last season. Eight of OU's 11 treys came in the opening half.
- OU also tied a season-high 19 assists on 25 made field goals as Gabbi Ortiz finished with five for the Sooners. Carter and T'ona Edwards tallied four assists apiece Thursday.
- The loss snapped OU's three-game winning streak against road non-conference opponents during the regular season.
- Kentucky's Makayla Epps led all scorers with 30 points, becoming the first player to score 30 or more points against the Sooners since Washington's Kelsey Plum finished with 30 points versus OU on Dec. 6, 2015.
- Oklahoma head coach Sherri Coale is 447-218 in her 21 seasons with the Sooners.

## INDIVIDUAL NOTES

### GIOYA CARTER

- Recorded a season-high 18 points on 7-of-12 shooting from the field. Carter has now finished with double-digit scoring 34 times during her OU career.
- Carter's seven made field goals were one shy of tying a career-high. The senior also set a season-high with four assists and four made 3-pointers.

### CHELSEA DUNGEE

- Finished in double figures for the second straight game, scoring 12 points in a season-high 26 minutes off off the bench Thursday night.
- Tied single-game highs for rebounds (4) and 3-pointers made (2).

### PEYTON LITTLE

- Eclipsed the 1,000-point mark for her career between Oklahoma and Texas A&M. Little now has 1,015 career points and has scored 859 points at OU. She needs just 141 more to become the 32nd player in school history with 1,000 points as a Sooner.
- Finished with a season-best five made 3-pointers at Kentucky, the most in a single game for the redshirt senior since knocking down five treys against Texas in the Big 12 Championships on March 5, 2015.
- Also tied a career-high with two blocks to led the team.

### GABBI ORTIZ

- Led Oklahoma with a team-high five assists against Kentucky. Ortiz has led the Sooners in assists four times in the first six games this season.

### VIONISE PIERRE-LOUIS

- Recorded her third double-double of the season with a 15-point, 13-rebound performance Thursday night. Pierre-Louis has four career double-doubles (all four coming in the last 10 games dating back to the 2015-16 season).
- Continues to average a double-double with 12.0 points and 10.4 rebounds per game through six contests.
