TEAM NOTES

- No. 12/12 Oklahoma fell to in-state foe Oral Roberts, 74-67, on Sunday inside Lloyd Noble Center. The loss snapped OU's 18-game winning streak over the Golden Eagles. OU fell to 5-2 this season, while Oral Roberts improved to 4-4. OU is now 21-15 all-time against Oral Roberts.
- Sunday's meeting was the first between the two teams since Dec. 3, 2005 and the first contest in Norman since March 17, 2001.
- Redshirt senior guard Peyton Little led the Sooners in scoring for the fifth time this season with 12 points on 4-of-14 shooting. OU is 3-2 this season and 33-14 all-time when Little leads the team in scoring.
- Junior center McKenna Treece finished with a career-high 11 rebounds in 24 minutes of action off the bench, surpassing her previous career-high of eight rebounds (vs. Kentucky, Nov. 28, 2014). The 24 minutes played by Treece also set a career high.
- For the third straight game, freshman guard Chelsea Dungee finished in double figures. In her second career start, Dungee scored 11 points on 3-of-5 shooting from the floor. She also made two 3-pointers for the third time in as many games.
- Senior guard T'ona Edwards contributed a season-best 10 points and logged a team-high three assists.
- Senior guard Gioya Carter finished with 11 points, her 35th career double-figure scoring game at Oklahoma.
- OU's starting lineup vs. Oral Roberts -- T'ona Edwards (G), Gioya Carter (G), Peyton Little (G), Chelsea Dungee (G), Vionise Pierre-Louis (C). The lineup was OU's fourth different starting five in seven games this year.
- Oklahoma head coach Sherri Coale is now 447-219 in her 21 seasons with the Sooners.
