JAN. 1, 2017 • #24/24 OKLAHOMA 87, TCU 72 • POSTGAME NOTES

TEAM NOTES

- No. 24/24 Oklahoma outscored TCU, 26-11, in the third quarter to knock off the Horned Frogs, 87-72, Sunday on Lloyd Noble Center. Peyton Little scored a game-high 25 points to lead the Sooners. OU improved to 11-3 and 2-0 in Big 12 play, while TCU dropped to 8-5 and 0-2 against conference opponents.
- The Sooners are 13-0 all-time against TCU in Norman and now lead the all-time series, 19-4. OU is 8-1 against TCU since the Horned Frogs joined the Big 12 Conference.
- For the second straight game, OU finished with 11 blocks, tying a season high. The 11 blocks against TCU are tied for the sixth-most in school history in a single game. Nancy Mulkey led OU with six blocks, just one shy of tying her career high. Four different players recorded at least one block in the victory.
- The Sooners set season highs in free throws made (26) and free throw attempts (35). OU finished with a .743 mark at the charity stripe against the Horned Frogs.
- OU won the rebounding battle, 53-38, over TCU. Vionise Pierre-Louis led the Sooners with a game-high nine rebounds off the bench.
- The Sooners finished with a .422 shooting percentage (27-of-64) in the victory Sunday, while holding TCU to .353. OU has won 28 straight games when posting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent. OU was 7-of-16 (.743) from 3-point range as Little hit 3-of-4 from deep.
- OU's starting lineup vs. TCU -- Gabbi Ortiz (G), Chelsea Dungee (G), Peyton Little (G), Maddie Manning (G), Nancy Mulkey (C). The Sooners are 2-0 this season when employing this lineup.
- Oklahoma head coach Sherri Coale is now 453-220 in her 21 seasons with the Sooners. She is 214-118 against Big 12 competition.

CHELSEA DUNGEE

- Picked up her sixth double-digit scoring game of the season with 11 points versus TCU. Dungee led the Sooners with a 5-of-6 performance from the free throw line.
- Hit a pair of 3-pointers against the Horned Frogs, tying her season high. Dungee leads OU with a .478 3-point shooting percentage.

PEYTON LITTLE

- Recorded a season-high 25 points on 9-of-15 shooting from the field and 3-of-4 shooting from beyond the arc. Little's 25 points against TCU rank as her second-best scoring total in her career as a Sooner.
- The Sooners are 5-2 this season when Little leads the team in scoring. OU is also 9-1 this year when Little scores at least 10 points in a game.
- The redshirt senior needs just 30 points to become the 32nd player in Oklahoma history to reach the 1,000-point scoring mark for her OU career. She has scored 1,119 points between her time at OU and Texas A&M.
- Led the team with four steals, one shy of a tying her season high.

MADDIE MANNING

- Picked up her seventh straight double-digit scoring game with 12 points. OU is 9-1 this season and 25-7 all-time when Manning scores 10-plus points.
- The redshirt senior also pulled down eight rebounds in the win.

NANCY MULKEY

- Led OU with six blocks, just one shy of tying her career high of seven set against Kansas on Dec. 30. Mulkey is second in the Big 12 conference with 2.4 blocks per game this season.
- Was 3-for-4 from the field to finish with eight points against the Horned Frogs. Also pulled down five rebounds in the victory.

GABBI ORTIZ

- Recorded a game-high six assists against TCU. Ortiz added in seven points and was one shy of tying a season high with seven rebounds in 24 minutes.

VIONISE PIERRE-LOUIS

- Nearly picked up a double-double with 13 points and nine rebounds off the bench in 16 minutes of action.
