TEAM NOTES

- No. 20/20 Oklahoma fell on the road Tuesday night, 86-68, to No. 12/14 Texas inside Frank Erwin Center. Down 11 points at halftime, the Sooners battled back to cut the Texas lead down to 58-56 with 7:36 left in the fourth quarter. OU clawed back in the second half by finishing 16-for-16 at the free throw line in the final two quarters, but Texas would close the game on a 20-4 run to hold off the Sooners.
- Texas improved to 13-4 this season and 7-0 in the Big 12, while Oklahoma fell to 14-5 overall and 5-2 against league opponents. The Longhorns lead the all-time series, 29-24, and are 16-8 against the Sooners in Austin.
- OU was nearly flawless from the free throw line, finishing 18-of-19 (.947) as the Sooners converted 18 straight after missing first their free throw attempt in the opening quarter. The .947 free throw percentage set a season high.
- The Sooners tied a school record for consecutive free throws made in a single game with 18 (Marist, 2004; Missouri, 1986; UNLV, 1980). The 18 straight made free throws are also the most ever against a conference opponent in the Big 12 era.
- The Sooners were a perfect 16-for-16 at the charity stripe in the second half. The 16 made free throws in the second half ties an OU record for most consecutive makes at the charity stripe in one half.
- Texas' 86 points were the most allowed by the Sooners in a game this season. The Longhorns also scored 46 second-half points, the most given up by OU in a game this season.
- OU starting lineup vs. Texas: Gabbi Ortiz (G), Gioya Carter (G), Peyton Little (G), Maddie Manning (G) and Nancy Mulkey (C): The Sooners are 1-1 when employing this starting lineup this season.
- Oklahoma head coach Sherri Coale is 456-222 in her 21 seasons and is 217-120 against Big 12 opponents during the regular season.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

CHELSEA DUNGEE

- Tied her season high with 15 points off the bench in 25 minutes of action against Texas.
- Was 10-for-10 from the free throw line, becoming the first OU player since Danielle Robinson in 2011 vs. Oklahoma State to record at least 10 makes at the line without a miss against a Big 12 opponent. Dungee's 10 made free throws are also the most by a Big 12 player in a conference game this season.
- Became the first Sooner to finish with 10 or more made free throws in a regular-season game since Maddie Manning finished 12-of-14 at the line against Texas in 2015.
- Has seven double-digit scoring games this season, which ranks as the fourth-most on the team.
- Has made 14 consecutive free throws dating back to Jan. 1 against TCU.

PEYTON LITTLE

- Passed Sunny Hardeman for ninth place in school history with 141 career 3-pointers as a Sooner. Little needs just four more trips to move into eighth all-time (Chelsi Welch, 144).
- Scored 14 points on 5-of-16 shooting, while adding in four rebounds and two steals in 31 minutes of action. The redshirt senior has scored in double figures 13 times this season and in 55 games at Oklahoma.
- Now has 1,035 points as a Sooner and needs just 54 more to pass Nicole Griffin for the 31st all-time on OU's scoring list.

GABBI ORTIZ

- Led OU with four assists against the Longhorns, marking the eighth time this year Ortiz has finished with the team lead in assists.

VIONISE PIERRE-LOUIS

- Recorded a team-high 16 points on 5-of-10 shooting from the field. Pierre-Louis led the Sooners in rebounding for the 11th time this season with seven boards.
- Picked up four blocks against Texas, tying a season high. The junior now has 108 career blocks and needs seven more rejections to pass Ashley Paris (114) for fifth all-time at Oklahoma.
- Now has 10 double-digit scoring performances this season and has scored 10-plus points 27 times in her career.
