TEAM NOTES

- Four Sooners scored in double figures as No. 18/22 Oklahoma swept the Bedlam series for the second time in the last three seasons with a 66-60 road win at Oklahoma State on Saturday inside Gallagher-Iba Arena. OU improved to 18-6 and 9-3 in Big 12 play, while the Cowgirls fell to 13-9 overall and 3-8 against league foes.
- The Sooners now lead the series, 61-40, over Oklahoma State and are 23-21 all-time against the Cowgirls in Stillwater. In the Big 12 era, OU is 14-7 on the road at Oklahoma State.
- The Sooners finished with a .500 (8-of-16) 3-point shooting percentage against Oklahoma State, matching its season high. It was OU's best performance from deep against a Big 12 team this season and the second time this year it recorded a .500 3-point field goal percentage (vs. Xavier, Dec, 19, 2016).
- OU improved to 13-0 this season and has won 34 straight games when posting a higher shooting percentage than its opponent. The Sooners outshot Oklahoma State, .407-.309, from the field, .500-.250, from 3-point range and, .875-.684, from the free throw line.
- For the sixth straight game, OU shot better than 80 percent from the free throw line, finishing with a .875 (14-of-16) clip from the line Saturday. Over the last six games, the Sooners are shooting .857 (87-of-102) at foul stripe. Gabbi Ortiz led the Sooners by knocking down all eight of her free throw attempts.
- The Sooners are 16-0 this season when holding their opponent to 70 points or less.
- OU starting lineup vs. Oklahoma State: Gabbi Ortiz (G), Gioya Carter (G), Peyton Little (G), Maddie Manning (G) and Nancy Mulkey (C): The Sooners are 5-2 when employing this starting lineup this season.
- Oklahoma head coach Sherri Coale is 460-223 in her 21 seasons and is 221-121 against Big 12 opponents during the regular season. Coale is 35-11 against Oklahoma State. OU has won 18 out of the last 24 meetings between the two teams.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

CHELSEA DUNGEE

- Scored 10 points off the bench to finish in double figures for the eighth time this season.
- Tied her career high with a pair of 3-pointers against the Cowgirls. Finished with six attempts from 3-point range, which is a career high for the freshman.
- Hit a pair of free throws in the win to improve her free throw percentage to .931 (27-of-29) in Big 12 play, which leads the Sooners.

PEYTON LITTLE

- Added 11 points to pick up her 18th double-figure scoring game of the season.
- Moved into 29th place on OU's all-time scoring list Saturday, passing Janet Freeman-Southard (1,092, 1979-82) and LaNae Jones (1,096, 1993-96). Little has recorded 1,103 points during her career as a Sooner.
- Recorded four of OU's eight steals in the win. The four steals by Little was just one shy of tying her career high.

MADDIE MANNING

- Finished with a team-high nine rebounds and added 11 points along with three assists in nearly 40 minutes of action at Oklahoma State. The redshirt senior hit a pair of 3-pointers in the victory and has made at least one triple in six straight contests.
- OU is 7-0 this season when Manning leads the team in rebounding.

GABBI ORTIZ

- Tied her season high with 17 points, while adding five rebounds and three assists in 37 minutes of action.
- Was 8-of-8 at the free throw line to lead OU, tying her career highs in both free throw makes and attempts for a single game. Ortiz's eight made free throws rank as the second-most by a Sooner in a single game this year. She has made 10 straight attempts from the free throw line.
- Knocked down a 3-pointer for the fifth straight game with a triple at the 5:23 mark in the third quarter.
- Has scored 10-plus points in four straight games and seven times in the last nine contests.
- OU is 7-1 in games when Ortiz leads the Sooners in scoring during her career.
