IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING 2017 STUDENT TICKETS

STUDENT TICKET SALE

2016 football student season ticket holders that plan to attend UNL in the fall of 2017 will be given first opportunity to order 2017 football student tickets, beginning November 19, 2016. The first date to order for students that **did not** have 2016 football tickets is January 16th. When purchasing football tickets, the East Stadium tickets will be sold until the allotment is exhausted. All students will know upon sign-up which stadium they have been assigned (East or South Stadium). 2017 volleyball and men's basketball student tickets will be made available beginning in the spring of 2017. Students will be notified of the exact sale dates via email. There is a limit of one student ticket, per sport, per order.

PAYMENT BY STUDENT BILLING

Your student account **MUST** be paid on time according to the student account policy to avoid cancellation of ticket(s). Assessment of late payment fees will apply as per the policy of the Student Accounts Office. **The student billing option is only for returning students.** Incoming freshmen and transfer students may only use the credit card option to pay for your tickets since you have not activated your student account. Using any other form of payment will render your order invalid. **With the early student ticket sale, student account billings for 2017 tickets will not be submitted to the Student Accounts office until March 2017.**

The Athletic Ticket Office does not guarantee a student ticket to every applicant.

NON-TRADITIONAL STUDENT SEATING (FOOTBALL)

Non-traditional student seating area will be made available for those students wishing to be seated outside of the general student population in the *South Stadium student section*. **You must request South Stadium when ordering and then notify the Ticket Office by May 1 if you wish to request non-traditional seating.**

SEATING CAPACITIES

The first students to arrive to each Men's Basketball game will be given access to lower bowl seating. When capacity is reached, students will be directed to standing room only. When the SRO area reaches capacity, students may be denied admission. When student floor seating capacity is reached for Volleyball, students will be directed to the standing room only area. Seating is on a first-come, first-serve basis. Students with season tickets are encouraged to arrive early!

REFUNDS

A full ticket refund (this does not include the \$5 application fee) will be given if the Ticket Office is notified **at least seven days prior to the first home game in writing**. After this time, refunds will be prorated based on public selling price. Refunds **WILL NOT** be automatically processed. **It is the student's responsibility to submit a written request for refund to the Ticket Office.** A student who has requested a refund may not reapply for a student season ticket.

STUDENT SPOUSE/DEPENDENT CHILD TICKETS

You **MUST** bring a marriage certificate in order to pick up a spouse ticket, and a birth certificate is needed to pick up a dependent child ticket. You must order a student ticket to be eligible to order a spouse or dependent ticket. A current full-time student ID **MUST** be presented to pick up your spouse/dependent (paper) ticket and presented with your ticket for entrance to all home games. **There is a limit of two (2) tickets per applicant at a discounted rate. This would apply to University employees that are also students.**

HOLIDAY BREAK GAMES (MEN'S BASKETBALL)

Games played during the Christmas holiday break will not be part of your student season ticket. You will receive an email in the fall with more information on how to obtain tickets for these games.

PICK-UP

Tickets will be delivered electronically to the N cards of all student season ticket holders. You must be a full-time student in the fall for tickets to be delivered to your ID. Full-time registration status will be verified in late August prior to ticket(s) being delivered.

IF YOU ARE ISSUED A NEW N CARD AFTER TICKETS HAVE BEEN DELIVERED, YOU MUST NOTIFY THE TICKET OFFICE NO LATER THAN 3 p.m. ON THE DAY *BEFORE* THE NEXT GAME YOU WISH TO ATTEND. IMPROPER USE OF TICKET PRIVILEGES MAY RESULT IN TICKETS BEING VOIDED FROM YOUR N CARD.

By checking the "I have read the 2017 Student Ticket Policies and Procedures" box, you confirm that you understand that you must be a **full-time Lincoln campus student** to receive tickets and you agree to the above terms and conditions.

The University of Nebraska and its employees reserve the right to refuse admission and the right to remove patrons from the venue at any time, for any reason, permitted by law.
