PRACTICE COVERAGE

Monmouth practices are open to the media, but please call in advance if you plan on attending. Practices during the week are usually from 2:00 pm-4:00pm. Players and coaches will usually be available after practice. Practice times may change without notice. Please contact the Monmouth University Athletics Communications office for the schedule.

MEDIA CREDENTIALS

Arrangements for media credentials for Monmouth softball games must be made through the Monmouth University Athletics Communications office. Requests by accredited media members should be made in writing and submitted on company letterhead to Greg Ott.


Priority of issuance of credentials will be given to daily newspapers and television stations which cover Monmouth softball on a regular basis.

Media and photo credentials must be requested at least 48 hours prior to any requested game.

MAC FACTS

- 153,200 square foot facility which will include state-of-the-art basketball lockerroom facilities.
- 4,100 seat competition arena will serve as a recruiting resource for scholar-athletes and stopping ground for Monmouth's 19 Division I Athletic Teams.
- Competition Arena for men's and women's basketball; also features a six-lane, 200 meter indoor track for year round training.
- Fitness Center with state-of-the-art cardiovascular and strength training equipment.
- Classroom and seminar space that can be quickly reconfigured.
- Conference Center will be able to house professional meetings or be partitioned for study halls, clinics and workshops.
- Home of the Leon Hess Hall of Champions and the brand new Monmouth University Sports Hall of Fame.
- Home of the brand new Varsity Club (hospitality for Blue/White Club Members).
- Student lounges and study areas with wireless internet access.

Monmouth University ushered in a new era in the school's history with the completion and opening of the long anticipated Multipurpose Activity Center in the Fall of 2009. The MAC will not only serve the school's 19 Division-1 athletics programs, but will also be a key asset for the entire Monmouth University community.

The new facility also features classroom and seminar space and a conference center that can be used for meetings, or be partitioned and used for study halls, clinics or workshops. The MAC, which features a state-of-the-art fitness center, will also be the new location of the Leon Hess Champions Hall, Monmouth Sports Hall of Fame and the Varsity Club, which will be used for hospitality for Blue/White Club members. Student lounges and study areas with complete wireless Internet access will also be in the MAC.

"Here we have a new home for every Monmouth University student, every faculty member, every employee, every alum," said university President Paul G. Gaffney II.

The MAC, which is connected to Boylan Gym and the Steadman Natatorium, is 153,200 square feet of new space for students and the community to utilize in many different capacities. The MAC's most prominent feature will be the 4,100 seat arena which will be the new nest for the MU men's and women's basketball programs. The arena also features a six-lane, 200-meter indoor track which will be used for training and competi-

tion all year long. A brand new fitness center with state-of-the-art strength and cardiovascular equipment will also be housed in the MAC.

"The hope and excitement people would have had years ago watching Boylan Gym open up, or the excitement that might have existed 25 years ago when the University decided that they should be a part of NCAA Division I athletics...does not even begin to match the excitement and energetic anticipation towards the opening of this facility," said Vice President and Director of Athletics Dr. Marilyn McNeil.

The MAC provides varsity athletes and coaches with meeting facilities, locker rooms, practice and competition facilities and expanded and upgraded amenities. The Monmouth University Bookstore was also relocated from the Stafford Student Center into the MAC, which will improve accessibility for commuting students, and the additional square footage will enable the stocking of a greater variety of merchandise for students and visitors.

The facility is part the University's ten-year strategic plan to make itself more competitive in attracting students. A core element of the vision is to enhance facilities that recognize the public nature of Division I Athletics and encourage participation from the campus community.



MU SOFTBALL PARK

Situated slightly northwest of the recently constructed, state-of-the-art Multipurpose Activity Center, the Monmouth University Softball Park is a natural grass softball facility that the Hawks call home. The Park is equipped with ample seating, two dugouts, and a new scoreboard with inning-by-inning scoring installed in 2013 for fans and players alike to enjoy the successes of Monmouth University softball.

The Hawks have seen many personal and team triumphs at the park, including a stellar senior season for Nichole Alvarez, who led the nation in batting in 2008 with an average of .480. Alvarez became the second player from a team in the Northeast Conference in the last 15 years to win the NCAA Division I batting title.
